

# Bay Oaks Newsletter May 2025

#### **May Business Meeting**

The May Business Meeting was held on Thursday, May 8, 2025, at 4:30 pm at the St. Rose de Lima Catholic Church, Holy Spirit Center, 301 South Necaise Avenue, Bay Saint Louis, MS 39520, during a break of the 2025 Quilt Show Setup. No member attendance count was taken but it was all hands-on deck for the Quilt Show setup. This included spouses and friends of members. Great turnout! Thank you all!

## **Charity Donation Chairperson**

Louise H is the Charity Donation Chairperson to support our Guild.

Louise set up Sew Day at the Kiln Library for October 4, 2025, from 9 am to 2 pm to work on fidget quilts for schools, kennel pads for the Friends of the Animal Shelter, and burrito pillowcases.

Kennel pads should be washable measuring 24 inches by 24 inches or 24 inches by 48 inches for the cages.

Members can make quilts to donate to the hurricane relief in North Carolina. The Guild purchased batting for these quilts. They can be throw size or larger and there is no deadline on turning them in. Each quilt will need a Bay Oaks Quilt Guild label. There are two different places we can send them: 5 Little Monkeys Quilt & Sew in Weaverville, NC, and Sharon B has contact information through an organization: Rice and Beans.

Sharon B previously mentioned that a good project would be to make pillowcases for residents of Dunbar Village possibly for Christmas. Sharon found out that Dunbar Village has 60 residents at maximum. Two-thirds are women and one-third are men.

Therese S previously reminded the Board that we had committed to making quilts for the four Kiln librarians and that it would be nice to have them done for December. One quilt is finished. Florence P and Sharon B donated two "quilt kits". Bill B and Sue C offered to finish them by December. Florence reported at the April Board Meeting that she made the last librarian quilt.

## Membership

Sherrie Q stated our membership was at 46 paid members. With the honorary member, Diana Kelly, the guild is at 47 members.

**Michele M** handled the I Spy for children (and adults). She had quite a few children find all the items on the list. The little prizes were appreciated.


**Kathy K** handled the work schedule for the Show. Thanks for organizing where members should be and taking care of situations that arose.



## Making a Rag Quilt Demonstration

Volunteer Sewing a Diagonal on Two of the Same Squares Together (Right Sides Facing Out). Later Sewing Another Diagonal, to Form an X, for the "Quilting".



Sewing the Squares in a Row - Careful About the Pattern. The Seams Should All Be On The Same Side



Sewing the Rows Together. Careful About the Pattern. All Seams Must Be on One Side



Sew a Half Inch Seam All Around the Quilt. Then Sew A Quarter Inch Seam To the Right of the Half Inch Seam All Around the Quilt. Careful On The Intersecting Seams - Nest Them Before Sewing Over Them.



The Quilted X's



The Side Without the Seams





After Quilt Outside Seams Are Done, Clip **Almost** to the First Seam On Each Square To Make a Fringe. Wash, Dry, Then Shake. Fringe Will Get Fuzzier Every Time You Wash the Quilt.

## **Breaking Down the Quilt Show**

The Quilt Show Breakdown is reversing the Setup process. As Quilts are taken down, tables are set up to sort the quilts by the quilter's name. When all a member's quilts are together and bagged, the member signs out on the same spreadsheet they signed the quilts in on.

## GSQA July Meeting, July 19, 2025

It was voted on at the March Business Meeting that our Guild would host the GSQA July meeting. Therese S has secured the venue used previously (First United Methodist Church in Long Beach). She will contact the following Guilds: Magnolia, Sand Stitchers, and Biloxi Lighthouse Stitchers to assist. Hosting the Meeting entails providing favors, snacks, and water as for previous GSQA meetings.

Therese suggested making fat-quarter roses. Judy F generously offered to donate the fat quarters needed. A summer theme was discussed so the fat quarters should be pastel colors.

The Guild will pay for the stems, leaves, and wire. We would need 150 roses. Guild members voted to make the roses. The fat quarter roses will be worked on after the Guild's Quilt Show. The other three Guilds would make up about 30 door prizes.



## Beckwith Retreat, August 14-17, 2025

The 2025 Beckwith Retreat dates are August 14th through 17th. Campers can arrive on Wednesday if they choose and pay \$50 per room for an additional night's lodging. The first meal provided will be Thursday lunch.

The cost for the Retreat is \$357 or \$119 for 3 payments per person for a double occupancy room and \$435 or \$145 for 3 payments per person for a single occupancy room which includes 2 meals Thursday and Sunday; and 3 meals Friday and Saturday. The Retreat is open to Guild members first with a limit of 20 people.

Therese started collecting for the Beckwith Retreat at the April 10th Business Meeting. Members can pay in three installments or in full. Our business meeting, originally scheduled for August 14th, will be rescheduled.
