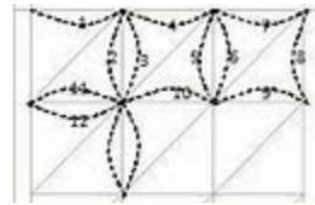
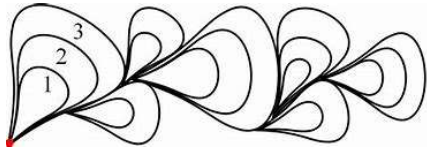

Handy Quilter's Tips

Low-cost rotary blades: Harbor freight carries blades for a fraction of the cost! Theirs are "carpet cutting blades". They are available to fit our quilting rotary cutters and work well.

Recycle batting scraps: pieces of leftover batting make great Swiffer floor duster refills. Also, larger pieces can be butted together and zig-zag stitched for use in quilts! Waste not, want not!
