I have a few thoughts on the Faces workshop.

My suggestion is for folks to go to the FreddyandJean shop on Etsy. They will see lots of possibilities and be encouraged to use just about any fabric for the background and face parts. The size is 20".

Making a few decisions ahead of time will help. Do you want to do yourself or anyone else in your imagination? Do you want to tell a story? What fabrics do you want to use? Yardage is not needed, just fat quarters or less, maybe a bit more for the background. I would suggest bringing multiple possibilities in order to have choices.

I will have drawings of noses, mouths, and eyes to use for ideas. I'm also bringing some samples Georgia and I made plus one made by Freddy Moran.

My hope is that this will be a fun and creative project!

Material List

Ironing surface (could be cardboard wrapped with flannel). This will be the surface for building the face and for fusing.

Scissors, fabric and paper

Sharpie

Fusible, approximately 1 yard

Pressing sheet/parchment paper

Several sheets of 8 1/2 x 11" computer paper

Fabric

Background-1-4 pieces to make a 20" square or 18 x 22 rectangle

Face-approximately 9" for face, 3" for neck

Fabric for hair, eyes, cheeks, mouth, nose, ears

Do you want to tell a story or represent someone? Google line drawings for pets, gardening, baking, art, music, quilting or other activities. Also think about accessories -earrings, hair, jewelry. I had fun with earring choices!
