ABOUT THIS SERIES QUILT

Warmth of Our Stars is a series quilt presented in six parts. Part One appeared in in *Love of Quilting's* January/February 2021 issue, and included materials and cutting instructions for all six parts. In Part Five you'll add some sparkle to the corners of the quilt when you make Scott's Corner Stars. Using matched sets of Flying Geese units for the star points adds a little cohesion to this scrappy quilt.

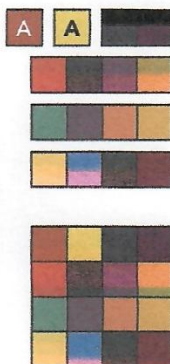

CORNER STARS ASSEMBLY

Use an accurate ¼" seam allowance throughout to ensure all elements of the quilt fit together well. To achieve Scott's scrappy look, randomly select assorted color patches. Use the 4 sets of 8 matching A squares mentioned in Part One for step 2.

BLOCK Y ASSEMBLY

1. Lay out 16 assorted color A's as shown in *Diagram XVI*. Join into rows; join rows to complete section 5. Make 4 total.



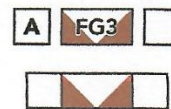

2. Referring to *Diagram XVII*, place assorted color A on white B, right sides facing. Sew diagonally; trim ¼" beyond stitching. Press open. Using a matching A, repeat on opposite end of white B to make Flying Geese 3. Make 4 sets of 4 matching total.

3. Join 2 white A's and 1 Flying Geese 3 as shown in *Diagram XVIII* to make section 6. Make 4 sets of 2 matching total.



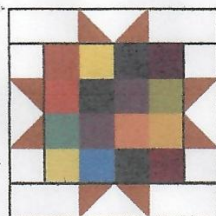
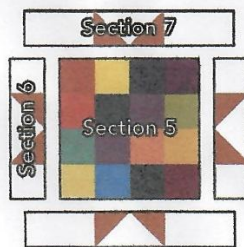

4. In the same manner, join 2 white B's and 1 Flying Geese 3 to make section 7 (*Diagram XIX*). Make 4 sets of 2 matching total.

5. Lay out 1 section 5 and matching sets of section 6 and section 7 as shown in *Diagram XX*. Join to complete block Y. Make 4 total.
