

WINIFRED'S PARTY

Susie C Shore Designs

Approximate finished size: 16 X 16

Materials (for each hat)

2 pieces of black or black print 18 X 18
1 piece fusible fleece 18 X 18
1 yellow/gold cotton 18 X 8 for buckle and star
1 cotton fabric for band 12 X 4
1 Pellon Fusible Fleece 18X 18
¼ yd. Heat-N-Bond paper backed fusible adhesive
16/90 sewing machine needle
See through presser foot will aid when stitching curves and corners

Usual Sewing Supplies

Sewing Machine
Iron
Ironing Board
Scissors
Marking pen
Pins
Ruler
Needle
Thread to match

Instructions

Make template by tracing pattern pieces and transfer any markings
Iron fleece onto backside of one black print
Layer both black print right sides together
Trace pattern on fleece and stitch around the outer edge using 1¼ inch seam allowance
Pivot and turn as needed leaving an opening as noted on pattern
Trim seam allowance to ¼ inch, clip into corners and curves as needed.
Turn right sides out, smooth all seam edges with a turning tool.
Press flat pressing the open edge under and flat. Whip stitch the edge closed or fuse.

On the Heat-N-Bond, trace One Hat Band and one buckle
Roughly cut out and fuse to the **wrong side** of buckle and band fabrics
Cut out on the traced lines
Remove paper backing and position on hat as noted on pattern
Fuse in place

Locate the Crown Lines on pattern and satin stitch (3.5 W .5L) starting on the Crown Line down and across the bottom of the Hat Band and back up along the opposite side of Hat's Crown; pivot and turn as needed. Next, satin stitch across the top edge of the Hat Band.

Top stitch around the Hat Brim as noted on the pattern with matching or contrasting thread

On the Heat-N-Bond trace one buckle and roughly cut out around traced lines. Fuse to the wrong side on buckle fabric. Remove paper backing and fuse to fabric

Cut out and place on band and fuse

Satin stitch as above around interior and exterior of buckle.

To Make Star

From the star fabric, cut 2 8" squares and a matching piece of Pellon fusible fleece.

Fuse the fleece to one of the star fabric Trace the star on the Pellon

Layer the Pellon and remaining star fabric right sides together

Stitch around the outer edge using $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam leaving an opening or bandage

Trim a seam to $\frac{1}{4}$ " clipping corners and turn right side out

Smooth and iron

The star can be sewn to the hat, glued or left unattached to use as a coaster.

****you can use a bandage instead of leaving an opening on both the star and hat

If it's hard to get edges smooth, use a bandage

Cut a slit on the back through the back layer only just big enough for turning

Make a Fabric Bandage by cutting a scrap fabric and fusible adhesive about $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by length of slit

Trim around edges to look like a bandage

Fuse in place
