## Bay Oaks Quilt Guild Portable Project Roll-Up October 28,2021 Sharon Barnes

Choose a decorative print for the exterior. Choose a solid for the interior that will not distract from your handiwork.

## Supplies:

1 yard cover fabric

1 yard fusible fleece \* (\$5 at Walmart)

1 pack Bias tape double fold .5 in wide or you can make your own approximately 95" of 2 % bias binding

1 yard of twill ribbon (or other type of tie)

½ inch pipe insulation (under \$2 at Lowe's and can cut 3; so share)

Thread to match

Usual sewing supplies

## Cutting: will save time if cut prior to class

cover fabric - cut a 24" X 36" rectangle fleece - cut a 24" X 36" rectangle cover fabric - cut 2 3 ½" circles pipe insulation - 24"

## Construction:

Start by gluing the circles to the ends of the insulation and secure with rubber bands. Let dry while making the carrier.

Layer the top and fleece **Or** top, wonder under, and flannel and press to adhere the layers together.

Round the two bottom corners of prepared rectangle.

Sew the bias tape to 3 sides leaving the top open. Start at one right angle corner. Sew the binding along the edge, around the curved corners and back to the right angle corner.

<sup>\*</sup>You can also use flannel and Pellon wonder under or Heat 'n Bond

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Press under about ¼" along raw edge on the top of the rectangle.

Fold again 3 1/2" down to make casing for tube. Sew close to bottom edge.

Fold the ribbon in half and center in the middle of the topstitching along the bottom of the roll. Machine sew securely.

Remove the rubber bands from the insulation tube and slip in the casing.

TaDa your roll-up is finished!!!!
