



Wisconsin Arabian Horse Association Youth Achievement Awards FAQ

➤ **Question: How do I submit my points?**

Fill out the Youth Achievement Awards Point Reporting document, which is found under the “Youth” tab on the WAHA website. It needs to be signed by the show secretary or the activity coordinator. It is then mailed to the current youth achievement award coordinator.

➤ **Question: What type of shows count toward the Youth Achievement Awards?**

All shows, except rated breed shows, including Arabian, National Show Horse, Palomino, etc. The shows that are counted include open shows, 4H, and Wisconsin Interscholastic Horsemanship Association shows.

➤ **Question: How do I earn points for the Horsemaster Category?**

A variety of activities are available! Participating in 4H meetings, hippology, volunteering at shows, volunteering at therapeutic riding centers, and assisting others at horse shows are some easy ways to get points. Check out the full achievement application for the list. If you have other ideas, feel free to contact the chair and see if we can get it added to the list!

➤ **Question: Do I have to own the Arabian/Half-Arabian I want to compete with?**

No! As long as the horse is registered, you just have to submit an application for each horse you want to earn points with. The rider/handler keeps the points earned by the horses and it counts towards the rider’s cumulative points. For example if Sarah shows both Lucky and Star, then she has to submit two applications (one for Lucky and one for Star), but the points earned by each horse will count towards Sarah’s merit awards.
