Please choose any recognized class from the AHA Standard Class List Divisions (AHA Comp. 304) except for: English or Western Trail, Cutting, Team Penning, ranch Sorting, Working Hunter, Hunter Hack, Cow Horse or Reined Cow Horse, ranch (other than Rail & Riding), Jumper, Eventing, Poles, Combined Driving, Dressage, Western Dressage, or Driven Dressage.

Option Class requests close at 7:00PM the evening before the show begins. AHA Option class fee includes the class and AHA fees.

Entry Instructions

Note: If entries are not complete a \$25 Incomplete Entry Fee will be applied

1. **All Owners, Trainers, and Exhibitors** participating must have AHA Competition membership cards. Alternatively, an entry may pay AHA Single Event Membership (SEM) fee. This is not required for opportunity or all-breed classes.
2. **Entry Form** must be complete with Owner/Trainer/Rider information and must contain 3 signatures on the back. An adult signature is required for all Youth exhibitors. Waiver & Release Liability Form MUST be signed and included.
3. **All entries** must include a signed check made payable to WAHA. Entries received without full payment of all fees will be considered post-entries.

General Information

This horse show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the Arabian Horse Association. The official rulebook of this organization will prevail for this show. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of these rules and is subject to these rules. Any changes or corrections of the rules will automatically become part of this prize list. Questions that may arise that are not covered by either AH rulebook will be decided by the Show Committee and their decisions will be final.

4. **Negative Coggins Test/Health Papers—Current Calendar Year:** A current year negative Coggins test (2024) is required for all horses on the grounds. The original Coggins report or an official Health Certificate with date of test and results must be presented at the Show Office with a copy left in the Show Office. Wisconsin law requires current health papers for all horses entering the state.
5. **Equine Influenza & Herpes Virus Vaccine Documentation may be requested—Within Last 6 Months:** Documentation of administration within the last 6 months for the Equine Influenza & Herpes Virus vaccines may be requested and sent in with stall request form. A copy will also need to be presented and left in the Show Office if not sent in with the stall request form. Horses may not be allowed off trailers without proper documentation. GR 845 (BOD 01/17/15, Effective 12/01/15)

HEALTH PAPERS/COGGINS TEST: An official health certificate issued within 30 days of the show by a licensed veterinarian must accompany all horses not residing in the State of Wisconsin. A negative Coggins certificate issued within the current calendar year must accompany all horses. The health and original Coggins certificates must be available for inspection at the time of check-in.

USEF GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule

- At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.
- In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.
- In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.
- In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their

temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.

- Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee. BOD 1/17/15 Effective 12/1/15.
6. **Only one horse per Entry Form** Enter complete name, address, zip code and phone contact number of owner. The owner(s) name on the entry must be the same as on registration papers or a copy of purchase agreement or sales contract must be included.
 7. **Horses** Include copies of registration papers for all horses entered. Horse's name must be entered as it appears on the registration papers. Enter all horse information requested on the entry form. Enter the rider's name, AHA number, classes to be entered, and total entry fees.
 8. **Trainer** Enter complete name, address, and contact phone number of trainer if other than owner. If there is no trainer, then owner must sign again as trainer on back of entry.
 9. **AHA Single Event Fee** A single event fee will be charged for every owner/rider/driver/handler/trainer that does not have a current AHA "competition" membership. AHA memberships may be applied for in the show office or online at arabianhorses.org. In the case of farm ownership, the farm must have a current AHA "business" card in the farm name. A "business" card is for ownership only. All riders/drivers/handlers must have individual AHA "competition" cards. AHA requires for results that all names be entered exactly as they appear on the membership card. See Fee table for current Single Event Fee charge.
 10. **Safe Sport Statement:** All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at <http://www.usef.org>
 11. **Indemnity and Non-Responsibility Clause:** All entries are accepted with the understanding that Wisconsin Desert Horse Association., the Arabian Horse Association, and Elkhorn Equestrian Facility and/or their agents will not be responsible for any loss, personal injury, or damage to people, animals, or property. "UNDER THE EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT, EACH PARTICIPANT WHO ENGAGES IN AN EQUINE ACTIVITY EXPRESSLY ASSUMES THE RISK OF ENGAGING IN AND LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR INJURY, LOSS OR DAMAGE TO PERSON OR PROPERTY RESULTING FROM THE RISK OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES."
 12. **Dressage riders:** Dressage/SHIH classes may not run by class number order or by day due to scheduling. Management has the right to limit Dressage Rides and SHIH Go's. Both are offered on a first come/first served basis.
 13. **Signatures on Entry Form** Make sure all signatures are on the entry blank, including permission for minor to show box. If there is no trainer, then the owner must sign again in trainer box. A minor cannot sign the entry form anywhere. A parent or guardian, agent, trainer must sign for a minor in required signature boxes and then print the name of the minor under adult signature.
 14. **Correct Entries** It is the exhibitor's responsibility to fill out entries correctly. No packets will be given out until entries are complete. Check the back of your back number to make sure you are entered in the correct classes. Please wear the correct back number for that horse to avoid incorrect results.
 15. **Cancellation or Substitution of Entries/Refunds:** All fees for entries including stall, office, AHA fees canceled before end of closing of entries will be refunded in full. No horse will be excused because of sickness after the closing date of entries without a Veterinarian Certificate which must include the horse's name, classes entered, symptoms, diagnosis, treatment, the veterinarian's original signature, address, and phone number. This will be reviewed by the Show Committee to determine if any refund will be given with the exception of the 9-90 fee. **Stalls may not be resold for any reason except by Show Management.** No substitution of horses will be permitted. USEF GR 911. All refunds will be made by mail after the close of the show. In the event of cancellation of classes due to severe weather or other emergency, refund of entry fees for canceled classes will be made upon

written request by the exhibitor within 30 days of the cancellation. USEF GR 832

16. **Officials:** If a show official fails to attend this show or to perform his/her duties for any reason, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a show official. USEF GR1211.2 (b)
17. **Registration:** To be shown in the AHA classes, horses must be registered with the Arabian Horse Association Registry or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry or the Canadian Half Arabian Horse Registry. If a horse is under one year of age, it must be eligible for registration, and the registration must have been applied for.
18. **Discipline:** Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, driver or handler will disqualify the horse from adjudication. Show Management reserves the right to remove any of the above listed from the show without being liable for compensation or damages (GR 702). Any action(s) against a horse by an exhibitor which is deemed excessive by a judge, federation steward, technical delegate or show veterinarian, in the competition ring or anywhere on the competition grounds may be punished by official warning, elimination, or other sanctions which may be deemed appropriate by the Show Committee. GR702 & 703
19. **AHA Member Statement:** Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches, and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership/competition card, join AHA or pay an AHA single event membership fee per competitor. When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA single event membership. Single event membership is not acceptable at AHA regional or national competitions. Exhibitors in walk-trot 10 & under classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions but must have an AHA membership with competition card at AHA regional and national competitions. Exhibitors in lead line classes or parents/guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership requirements (BOD 5/12)
20. **Physical Inspection:** All animals are subject to a physical inspection at no charge by Show Management at the discretion of the Show Committee as a safeguard against communicable diseases. Any horse who exhibits questionable symptoms must be immediately removed from the show grounds. Examinations or treatment not requested by show officials shall be on a private practice basis.
21. **Attendants/Grooms/Headers:** No person will be permitted to enter the ring except participants in the class, judges, their assistants, and show officials. Attendants, grooms, and/or headers may enter the ring only when summoned by order of the judge. Headers will be permitted in all driving classes.
22. **Stallions:** Purebred Arabian Stallions may be shown by ladies and junior exhibitors in any class open to purebred Arabian stallions except Lead Line, Showmanship and Walk-Trot classes.
23. **Class Size:** The Show Committee reserves the right to split any class with duplicate awards presented. Any class may be canceled, divided, or combined at the discretion of the show management.
24. **PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM: Calls for classes are provided as a courtesy.** Classes will be called promptly. Up to two minutes may be allowed after the first horse enters the ring. If an exhibitor has a succeeding class, he/she must notify the person in charge of the gate that he/she may need more time. A three-minute tack change may be allowed if the gate person has been notified at least two (2) classes in advance. Responsibility for entering classes rests with the exhibitor. In the event of failure of the sound system, exhibitors must be ready to enter the ring at the appropriate time.
25. **NO SHOWS:** There will be a \$5 penalty assessed for "no shows." If you have entered a class and are not going to show in that class, you must notify the Show Office and gate before that class enters the ring or pay a \$5 penalty/class. There will be NO REFUND for No Shows.
26. **Entry Refusal:** The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries of any exhibitor at their discretion as stated in the current USEF Rule Book.
27. **Hoof Length, Shoes, and Pads:** Management reserves the right to request measurement of toe

length, shoe dimensions, and remove shoes and/or pads for hoof inspection of any and all horses in any class. Shoes may be pulled and inspected at random.

28. **Dressage Dress & Equipment Rules:** When cross-entry by rider or horse/rider combination is permitted between Dressage and other Arabian classes at a competition, DR 120 and DR 121 apply only to the designated Dressage warm-up and competition arenas, or when an exhibitor is actually warming-up for Dressage class(es).
29. **Protective Headgear:** Any rider may wear protective headgear in any division or class without penalty from the judge. Dressage attire requires the use of an ASTM certified helmet. USEF strongly encourages all riders to wear protective headgear. It is the responsibility of the rider, parent, guardian, or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see that the headgear worn complies with safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition. Refer to current USEF Rule Book
30. **WARM-UP FACILITIES & COMPETITION ARENAS:** The indoor rings are 115' wide by 208' long. The footing is sand mixture. Warm-up rings are 100' wide x 100' long and the footing is a drained sand mixture. MR competition ring is arena #2 and warmup arena #4. SH/DR competition ring is arena #3 and warmup arena #5. **The warmup and competition rings will be open starting Thursday, 7/30.**
31. **Pets:** All pets must always be on a leash and are prohibited in the Show Arena. Pet owners are required to supply an official rabies vaccination certificate showing the date and serum used. Proof of service dog status is required and must be promptly shown when asked. GR1301.6
32. **SMOKING:** Smoking in the barns is not permitted. This will be strictly enforced.
33. **CAMPING:** Camping is available at the cost of \$40 per night.
34. **Sharps Containers:** Refer to USEF GR1210. As per USEF rule GR1210.4, all used needles and other disposable sharp instruments must be placed in sharps containers. Per rule GR 1210.4, competition management will fine any individual including trainers, owners, exhibitors, and their agents \$100.00 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.
35. **Halter Classes:** Horses must be at the gate and ready to enter the ring. Any horse who is not present and ready will not be admitted to the class. Products may not be applied to hoof or hide to conceal a conformation defect. Clear or transparent products may be used on hooves for Breeding or In-Hand classes. All Halter classes will be judged comparatively, and the In-the-Ring procedure will be used.
36. **STALLS:** Stalls are shed row with a lime base and vary in size based on barn. The Barn Manager will be available at noon, July 30th until one half hour after the close of the show. Stall assignments will be posted on the show office door after hours. **Bedding must be pre-ordered.** No grain or hay will be available.
37. **STALL DECORATIONS:** All stall curtains and materials must be certified fireproof and/or a fire extinguisher must be present. **Damaged Stalls** will be charged a \$150.00 damage fee.
38. **OPEN CHECKS:** No open checks will be accepted for pre-entry fees or stall reservations. All pre-entries and stall reservations **must** be accompanied by fully complete negotiable checks dated on or before the closing date. Entries received without such checks will be charged post entry fees. **All files must have an open check with the secretary during the show.**
39. **Motorized Vehicle Statement:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damage, claims, losses, or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled

scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed “unsafe use” if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

40. **MOTORIZED VEHICLES AND MINORS USEF Rule GR901.29/GR1301.7/GR1301.8:** Minors who do not have a valid driver’s license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver’s license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
41. 42. **Location of Classes:** Management reserves the right to hold classes or a portion of classes on the grounds at an appropriate location other than the arena, if necessary. Show Management reserves the right to make changes in procedures, rules & regulations as shall be deemed to be in the best interest of the show.
43. **Printing Errors:** The Show Committee is not responsible for errors in printing. Correction of any errors will be posted in the show office.
44. **Option Classes:** Option classes may be purchased by any exhibitor. All purchases must be completed by 7 pm on the day before the show begins. Other exhibitors may then enter the class at any time prior to the class being held with no post entry fee. Select the option class you want and request your first, second, and third choice for placing that class in the class schedule. Only 2 option classes per session are allowed. Show management will make final decisions on placement.
45. **Determining Maiden, Novice, Limit horse/rider:** Ribbons won in one-horse classes do not count in reckoning the maiden, novice or limit status of either horse and/or rider/driver in any division. GR135.3. The status of Maiden, Novice or Limit entries is as of the closing date of entries. . Maiden—no firsts, Novice—has not won three firsts, Limit has not won six firsts. **Do not count wins in one-horse classes.**
46. **NQ:** Abbreviation for Non-Qualifying
47. USEF Membership Requirements
 - A Competing Membership is only required for athletes seeking HOTY points or those signing the entry blank as the trainer/coach (see below).
 - Owners of horses seeking HOTY points must be competing members and the horse must have a recording. Trainer or coach must be a Competing Member and sign the entry blank.
 - Youth competing without a trainer or coach will have a parent sign as trainer or coach and the parent must be a Competing Member.

- • Those competing without a trainer or coach will be required to sign the entry blank as the trainer/coach, therefore must have a Competing Membership. (GR404.4) Show Passes are not required. • All participants in a USEF Lite competition agree to becoming a USEF Fan as a condition of participation in the competition (at no cost to the participant).
48. USEF Safe Sport Requirements Non-Federation members, Competing Members under the age of eighteen (18), Subscriber members, and Fans are not required to complete the SafeSport Training. Exceptions – SafeSport Training is required for: • Any individual signing an entry blank as Trainer or Coach (including anyone competing without a trainer/coach), must have completed the SafeSport Training prior to the first day of competition. •
49. **Youth competing without a trainer or coach will have a parent sign as trainer or coach and the parent must be a competing member and have completed the SafeSport training •**
Competition Manager(s), Secretary, and any person acting in the role of a licensed official are bound by all requirements of the USEF Safe Sport Policy. • Any Competing Federation Member eighteen (18) years of age or older must have completed the SafeSport Training prior to the first day of competition. Participants in a Lite competition will be under the jurisdiction of the U.S. Center for SafeSport and will be subject to the U.S. Center of SafeSport Code and USEF Safe Sport Policy and afforded all related protections.
50. **Photography:** Show management has contracted with a professional photography company to provide official show photography services. Photographs will be taken of exhibitors/horses in each class and made available for purchase on the Official Photographer's website. No other person may photograph, sell, or give away images taken from the show ring without prior written consent from the Official Photographer. Persons may, however, photograph family members and their own horses. Contact the Official Photographer with any special requests.

Other Rules & Specifications

51. USEF rules are in force from the moment show management allows access to the show grounds. This includes conduct, correct saddlery and equipment, and attire. Visit the USEF website for the most current rulebook, www.usef.org.
52. **Reminder:** All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.
53. **Liability** – Horses by their inherent nature present a risk. This show, the management, the USEF Licensee, and the facility will not be responsible for any loss or damage or injury to horses exhibited, or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed, or in any way injured. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person, whomsoever, by any horse owned or exhibited by said exhibitor and shall indemnify the show, the management, the show committee and volunteers, the USEF Licensee, the USEF and USDF, or any member thereof, against all claims and demands, of any nature or kind, that may grow out of any injury occasioned by any horses owned or exhibited by them, or arise from the negligence of the person in charge of any such horse. All horses exhibited in this show participate entirely at the owners risk. Neither the Organizing Committee, show volunteers and staff, the facility or its owners, any host GMO, USEF or USDF or their members will be responsible for any damage, injury, or loss to persons, horses, or property of exhibitors or spectators. All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damage to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance

providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date.

54. **USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT (GR901.9): LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE MODIFIED LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, OR AGENT, AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A SHOW PASS FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE: 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT (EXCEPTION: FRIESIAN PERFORMANCE FR231) AND ACADEMY CLASSES (ACADEMY CLASSES ARE CLASSES LIMITED TO HORSES USED REGULARLY IN A LESSON PROGRAM); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS. 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES, 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION, 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.**

Leased horses need a copy of the lease agreement. No leased horses may be exhibited in an Amateur Owner class. Enclose a copy of the registration papers for each horse and copies of AHA membership cards for each owner, trainer, and exhibitor.
2. AHA non-members may pay a \$40 single event membership fee. Walk-trot 10 & Under, Leadline exhibitors, and parents who sign for their children are not required to be members of AHA.
3. The back of the entry form must have every exhibitor, rider, owner, driver, handler, coach and trainer (trainer in this sense means the person taking care of the horse) signature or his/her agent(s) must sign the entry blank. GR 908 A parent/guardian signature for all exhibitors under the age of 18 years is required.
4. Include a photocopy of the horse's negative Coggins Test dated within the last 12 months. The original copy will be verified at check-in.
5. Include a photocopy of the horse's Equine Influenza & Herpes Virus Vaccine Administration within the last 6 months.
6. Enclose your check or other payment instrument made out to **WAHA**, signed, and dated. Also enclose the stall request sheet located within this booklet. **If a tack stall is being shared by two or more people, the cost of the stall must be paid in full by one person.**
7. Post-entered horses will be charged post entry class fees except for Option Classes.
8. No fee will be charged to change a class if a class is added **at the same time** a class is scratched. Scratched classes will not be refunded. The scratch and add must be completed in the show office prior to the classes scratched and added. **Any classes scratched or any class that the competitor doesn't show without notifying the office or paddock manager will be charged a \$5.00 scratch fee.**
9. Settlements will be calculated and paid for in their entirety by either the trainer or the owner. Settlement of fees and closing out open checks should be done no less than one hour after the last class ends. You may check out earlier when you have entered the last class—but make sure it is the last class.

Stabling and Warmup / Competition Rings: Stalls and rings will be available at noon on Thursday, July 30th. We will be using arena # 3, which is a covered show arena. Arena # 5 is a warmup arena.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. GR844 Equine Vaccination Rule

1. At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino-pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.
2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.
3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.
4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.
5. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee.
