### **Definitions:**

Jr. Jr.: Exhibitor 13 years and under

Jr.: Exhibitor 18 years old and under

Sr.: Exhibitor 19+ years old

**Novice Horse:** Horse has not won 3 firsts in division with ANY handler/rider.

**Novice Rider**: *Rider* has not won 3 firsts in division on ANY horse.

**Restricted walk/trot:** Horse/Rider combination cannot enter canter classes.

Exhibitor/Horse age: Age as of 01/01/2020

### **Rules & Show Information:**

- 1. COVID-19 Safety Waiver Please see 2020 WAHA Horse Show Safety Protocol waiver for the 2020 WAHA Fall Colors Horse Show.
- 2. ALL HORSES MUST HAVE A CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS, assessed within the current year, prior to unloading the horse from the trailer. The exhibitor must provide a copy to the show office to retain. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- **3.** All exhibitors must have a signed entry form/waiver, including the WAHA Safety Protocol waiver. A parent or legal guardian must sign the entry form/waiver for all minors (under 18 years old).
- 4. All minors (under 18) must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- 5. All checks shall be made payable to Wisconsin Arabian Horse Association (WAHA) for all show fees and shavings.
- 6. Pre-entries are due by October 3rd via online entry or mailed with a check to Karissa Held 5860 County Road F, Mazomanie, WI 53560.
- **7.** Office fees will be waived for pre-entries. Pre-entry participants will also receive one free raffle entry for a Kwik Trip \$25 Gift card (2) and feed bag drawings.
- **8.** All entries received by the show must be paid in full with cash or check, prior to entering the arena.

- 9. Stalls are available via reservation mailed by October 3rd and are non-refundable. Early arrival Friday after 12PM can be coordinated by request with Tammy Teubert grassponi@yahoo.com. Checks must be mailed to reserve a stall. Stalls will be available 7:00 AM the day of the show; no overnight stalls are available Saturday night. Limited stalls will be available the day of the show on a first-come-first-serve basis.
- 10. Shavings are not included in the stall fee. Shavings may be ordered prior to the show by mailing a check payable to WAHA to Karissa Held 5860 County Road F, Mazomanie, WI 53560.
- 11. No refunds for scratched classes or stalls unless a vet or medical excuse is provided to show management.
- 12. Appropriate show clothing or academy attire is required. Helmets are encouraged for all exhibitors and will not be penalized.
- 13. Training equipment is NOT allowed while showing.
- 14. Leashed dogs are permitted on grounds. No dogs are permitted in the indoor arena (exception: service dogs).
- 15. WAHA, Walworth County Fairgrounds, and the show staff shall not be held liable for the inherent risks associated with equine activities.
- 16. All horses must be entered in a class to be on the grounds.
- 17. All horses must pay either a stall fee or a trailer fee.
- 18. Exhibitors must bring their own "buck" (dollar) for ride a buck. The winner will keep all of the dropped dollars.
- 19. Liberty class entries must provide their music and a person to play the music on a phone or tablet at the announcers stand.
- 20. Must be present to win and pick up highpoint and raffle awards. Awards will not be mailed.
- 21. The exhibitor with the most points will choose from the highpoint awards first for their category. The second highest point earner will get the second pick of highpoint prize. The third highpoint winner will get the remaining prize.





Friends and exhibitors, in order to move forward with the show, we must place the health and safety of all first. WAHA Fall Colors Show Committee has put this Safety Protocol in place in accordance with the recommendations of the CDC, State of Wisconsin, and Walworth County Public Health Department regarding social distancing and public health. We ask everyone to help us have a great show by reading and following the guidelines. **Thank you!** 

Exhibitors are asked to refrain from attending the show if they have been in contact with anyone exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms within the last 14 days, have a fever or other symptoms, or are immune compromised.

# Exhibitors and others in attendance are required to wear masks within the indoor arena and are strongly encouraged to wear masks elsewhere on the fairground facilities.

Exhibitors and Show Facility

- Exhibitors must submit a signed WAHA Horse Show Safety Protocol waiver with their entry forms.
- People on foot must follow social distancing guidelines of six feet apart at all times and shall not congregate in groups larger than 10 people.
- This event is closed to the public, no spectators are allowed. Please limit the number of people who come to the show with each exhibitor to essential people only.
- All dogs must be on leashes at all times. No dogs allowed in the indoor arena or at the show office.
- No chairs are allowed in the indoor arena. All bleachers in the indoor arena will be subject to appropriate six feet of social distancing and face coverings.
- Arena entrance/exits will be arranged so that the riders are not coming in close contact entering and exiting the arenas. Riders are to follow directions for entering/exiting. Loitering is not allowed around the gate areas.
- Riders shall follow social distancing guidelines at all times including, but not limited to the warm-up and show arenas.
- Respect the gate person's personal space and maintain proper social distancing when interacting with him/her.
- Only exhibitors entered in the class immediately following the class that is working in the arena may be in the warm-up area. Only one adult may accompany each exhibitor to the holding/warm-up area. No children on foot allowed in the warm-up/holding areas.
- No foot traffic allowed at the in-gate with the exception of one adult with a Youth Walk-Trot or Jr.Jr. exhibitor may be in the area for safety purposes.

Show Office

• Show office capacity will be limited to one person at a time. Children may not accompany adults to the show office.





- No contact option to limit interaction with the show office, mail entries along with checks and all necessary paperwork (entry form, negative coggins report, and signed Safety Protocol waiver) can be sent directly to show management at 5860 Cty Rd F, Mazomanie WI 53560. You will find all forms on our website: <u>https://wisconsinarabian.com/shows</u>. Please check-in at the office the day of the show to receive your back number if you don't already have one.
- If you do not pre-enter, please have all paperwork filled out prior to coming to the show office. You will need your entry slips filled out completely, a completed and signed Safety Protocol waiver, negative coggins report, and a form of payment (cash or check). Back numbers will not be given out without the required paperwork.
- Show office will provide at least six feet of distancing for the check-in area and in locations where lines form.

Food Stand

- There will be a food stand on the grounds, run by WAHA. All food will be individually pre-packaged.
- Masks are required in the indoor arena where the food stand is located.
- Please respect others if waiting in line and maintain proper social distancing of six feet.
