Trail Riding Division

Trail riding miles are self-reported. 1 point will be earned for every mile logged. Miles must be logged within 15 days after the ride. All miles must be turned in before the October 31st cut-off date to be counted.

RULES

GENERAL

1. WAHA Membership Guidelines:
 - All participants in this program must be members of WAHA (full membership or associate) in order to compete and receive awards.
 - WAHA Members are able to enter their age category (divisions 20-23) free of charge provided they submit necessary entry forms.
 - Only one (1) horse owner is required to be a WAHA member to enter the program and track points for their horse. This means, said horse owner is able to track points for divisions 1-17 regardless if they were the rider or handler of the horse. Points earned in these divisions carry with the horse and shall count towards horse divisions, Legion of Merit (LOM), and Supreme Legion of Merit (SLOM) awards depending on what the horse is entered in. (An example: A horse owner enters their horse in the point program and tracks points earned when their trainer competes with their horse in the division entered) However, If rider(s) or handler(s) wish to compete in their age division for awards, they must be WAHA members and submit the necessary entries for their free age division category.
2. Horse(s) must be registered Arabian, Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian (AHA) OR must be pending registration and able to provide copies of registration papers by October 31st of the current enrolled year.
3. Points will accumulate from November 1st to October 31st of the current year. You must submit all points, trail rides, and endurance ride points by the cut off of October 31st to count.
4. The point system, LOM and SLOM programs can be entered at any point during the year.
5. You must enter the Point System prior to participating in shows to be counted. This will be enforced.

FEES

6. There are several fee options for entering the point system:
 - Flat Rate - Exhibitors can pay a flat rate of \$150 to enroll a horse/rider in the point system, LOM/SLOM, AND enter unlimited divisions. Reminder: Starting in 2020, the fees for divisions 20-23 are waived for WAHA members. Members must submit necessary paperwork to enroll and report their points in order to receive awards.
 - Non-Flat Rate - Annual nomination fees will be \$15 per division or \$40 for any three (3) divisions.
 - LOM/SLOM Program - The initial nomination into the WAHA LOM/SLOM Program is \$50, followed by a \$40 renomination fee for every subsequent year (LOM/SLOM entry is included in Flat-Rate option).
7. Entry fees will not be refunded except for the following reason. If a horse is entered in the point system and has not sent in any points, the owner may apply for a full refund upon presentation of a vet certificate. Any horse withdrawn from the point system in this manner may not re-enter the point system for that year. Once points have been sent, no refunds will be given.

POINT TRACKING

8. Points will be counted only from the divisions entered. Note: You must enter the division for the classes you want to earn points in – if you are not entered in the division, you cannot count the points.
9. Two Options for Point Reporting:
 - Paper Form Reporting - Point forms must be completely filled out along with an official class list provided. Point reporting forms must be mailed to the appropriate Point System Secretary within 15 days of the last date of the show (enforced by US Postmark; postage meters are not acceptable).
 - Paperless Online Point Reporting - Starting in 2020, online point submission forms are available at the links below. Points must be accurately reported within the google form(s) and submitted within 15 days of the last date of the show. A digital copy of the show bill must be uploaded within the form for the submission to count. One online form contains up to 8 classes, if more room is necessary - enter an additional form and submit it.

RULES

10. Starting in 2020, Points earned in closed shows, such as 4-H or restricted breed shows and classes (National Show Horse, MAHB Fall Festival, Pinto, Palomino, etc.), WILL be counted. Points earned at these shows will count as regular rated/open show points and may be recorded on those forms.
11. Only one set of points can be counted per class. For example, in a Regional class where a Top Five and a Reserve Champion or Champion is received, only the highest placing may be counted.
12. All points for all divisions will be based on the type of show in which they were held (for example; National level competition vs. Open show competition).
13. AHA Regional Sweepstakes halter classes points will count the same as regional classes.
14. Any competitor may check their points with the Point System Secretary at any time during the year. No questions regarding other competitors will be answered. If inquiring by mail, a stamped, self-addressed envelope should accompany request.
15. All WAHA competition placings count for double points within the WAHA Point System (See point chart for details).

EXHIBITOR DIVISIONS

16. Exhibitor divisions 18-23 are open only to juniors and amateurs. Submit one form per horse per show.
 - Starting in 2020, WAHA Members are able to enter their age category (divisions 20-23) free of charge provided they submit necessary entry forms.

AWARDS

17. Awards will be given in each division. Points for all awards, including the WAHA Legion of Merit and WAHA Supreme Legion of Merit, will be counted only from divisions entered. At least 6 horses must be entered in a division to receive a high point award. Divisions with less than 6 entries will be awarded ribbons only.
18. Exhibitors have the option to select their desired overall high point award in the event that they win. See entry form for more details.

HIGH POINT

19. In addition to division awards, High Point awards will be awarded in the following provided there are a minimum of 6 entries per competing division: High Point Halter Stallion, High Point Halter Mare, High Point Halter Gelding, High Point Performance (any sex), and High Point Horse (any sex; halter and performance points required).
20. Points earned in any of the listed divisions except Divisions 1-16 will count toward High Point awards. Division 17 will have its own High Point if enough horses are entered.
21. Awards will be presented in January at the annual WAHA meeting and awards banquet. Winners will be notified via email. Plan to attend or send a representative as awards will not be mailed.

LEGIONS

LEGION OF MERIT AWARD

Open to Purebreds, Half-Arabians and Anglo Arabians. Horse may earn LOM only once. New points required for the WAHA Legion of Merit. An appropriate trophy will be given to all horses earning 1,000 points in the point system. Horses that have been entered in the program (in 2002 & prior years) will be grandfathered and only require 750 points to win this award. Any horse entering the program for the first time in 2003 & after, would be required to earn 1,000 points. A \$50 entry fee is required the first year. Thereafter, an additional \$40 renomination fee will be required for each succeeding year. An additional bronze (WAHA LOM) can be ordered (for the rider of the horse if different than the owner) provided the owner fills out the required form and pays the additional fee for the cost of the bronze.

SUPREME LEGION OF MERIT AWARD

Open to Purebreds, Half-Arabians and Anglo Arabians. Horse may earn SLOM only once. Horses that have earned the WAHA Legion of Merit may continue in the WAHA Point System. Starting in 2004, horses earning 1,000 additional points in the WAHA system will receive an award for WAHA Supreme Legion of Merit. Nomination fee will be \$50 the first year and \$40 for each year thereafter. All rules are the same for the Supreme Legion of Merit as the Legion of Merit award. An additional bronze (WAHA LOSM) can be ordered (for the rider of the horse if different than the owner) provided the owner fills out the required form and pays the additional fee for the cost of the bronze.

Starting in 1993, horses that have not been in the WAHA Legion of Merit program but have been in the WAHA Point System may use points earned in 1993 and subsequent years toward the Legion of Merit. The fee is \$50 per year that WAHA Point System points are converted to LOM points. The required forms must be filled out by the exhibitor. Supreme Legion of Merit begins in 2004 and no points will be counted prior to 2004.

The WAHA Board starting in 2000 has authorized a new program. Horses that have been in the AHA Achievement Awards Program (Legion of Honor, Legion of Supreme Honor, Legion of Excellence, Legion of Merit, Legion of Supreme Merit and Legion of Masters) may apply those points toward their WAHA Legion of Merit. The fee for this service is \$50 nomination fee, entry fees for the division in which the points were earned plus \$200. All the required WAHA reporting forms must be filled out and submitted by the member requesting this service. Copies of the AHA Event Record must accompany the WAHA Point System Reporting forms.

SUPREME LEGION OF MERIT
