PREFACE: WHY WE ARE COMING FORWARD

What you are about to read is **shocking**. It is also, likely, our country's best last shot to properly align AI. Or, at worst, a story that slows our country's descent into disinformation-fueled **civil war**.

- I have been a top **AI, disinformation, and free speech** expert for 20 years. It is **not surprising** that my teams – two decades of top world experts and hundreds of students, teachers, lawyers, lawmakers, artists, and volunteers – **ended up with the “receipts.”** **But it is a national scandal that no one else did.**

My team – including young people in **Minneapolis** – **risked their lives and careers for the country**. There are backstage plot points – **bullets, evacuations, NDAs, sabotage**, and the sheer stakes re: AI and humanity – that are, frankly, not for the faint of heart.

To **avoid re-traumatizing my teams**, and keep this opportunity optimistic, **we often tell the story “funny.”**

I am many things, but a **graphic designer** is not one of them. I ask that you look past “how” our assets look and recognize what other experts, journalists, and now even the AI itself (fwiw) sees: We are the **“Last Manhattan Project Standing.”** And, I assure you, we wish it were otherwise.

- The **IDH** – and its unicorn “story” – are now **strategic assets that need to be immediately protected, funded, and scaled** to begin re-empowering the thousands of other displaced “neutral narrative theory experts.” We need them back at the AI alignment table – and at work on the frontlines of disinformation and college reform – for America to have any chance of winning (or surviving) the 21st century.

That is why we are coming forward. Period.

The Institute for Digital Humanity (IDH) is a non-partisan non-profit. The IDH was founded in 2019 when its Executive Director (Dr. Aaron McKain), left liberal higher education and became an “**echo chamber diversity hire**” at a **MAGA-adjacent Bible college** in downtown Minneapolis to **unite political/religious organizations** (programmed to hate each other) on **fixing the tech** dividing us.

It worked.

- The IDH’s “**impossible**” **bipartisan coalitions** include **DNC/RNC lawmakers; Jewish, Christian, and Muslim** orgs/leaders; the **ACLU, ADL, Bar Associations, Big 10** schools, a **Netflix** doc, **international artists**, and 100s of volunteers from “both sides” of reality.
- **Then, because we live in Minneapolis, all hell broke loose. Twice.** In **2020-21** (the IDH “won” in “wartime conditions” for \$300k) and in **2026** (during our re-launch).¹

We are not **geniuses**: Our solution was a “**layup**” blocked by an **alarming systemic intelligence failure**.²

- The IDH is the third phase of a 20 year, multi-industry initiative (using a holistic, dead-neutral, and Constitutional meta-methodology) to **properly align/guardrail AI**, solve **disinformation** (in time to **stop a civil war**), fix the **college free speech crisis**, restore our **shared civic reality**, and secure **U.S. AI supremacy in the 21st century**.³
- As we explained to *CBS news* on the eve of the 2024 election (and in detail on *Canada’s News Forum* in 2025): We were simply 20 years early, used the **correct methodology** (narrative theory), got the **receipts**, and **survived** (barely, because we’re bipartisan) **the political/institutional insanity** of higher ed and post-digital America.

¹ After the Bible college made headlines for **hosting the Floyd Memorial**, IDH dealt with **evacuations**, militias, **NDA**s, IP embargoes, and the **attempted shooting of Dr. McKain**. To keep our city safe/sane, we – by design – **converted** our **disinfo networks into civic collapse “crisis mode”**: **Hosting bipartisan town halls** w/ electeds on COVID/privacy; **art exhibitions** on pandemic trauma, **cross-cultural news** networks to “**ground**” reality amidst chaos and guns, and mutual aid (**raising \$27k** to keep partners fed).

² In “**Silicon speak**,” Dr. McKain is a “**Systems Architect**” and “**AI Governance & Alignment Director**”: He developed a unified meta-method (OS) for **socio-technical alignment** (**one stack** to manage the entire systemic crisis of AI, disinfo, free Speech, and privacy); architected **nationally scalable, multi-industry AI governance systems**; and operationalized a **dead-neutral, cross-domain, Constitutional alignment framework** (law + safety + context + disinfo) across hostile “real world” ideological divides.

The **punchline** is that our **20 year head start** comes from Dr. M using **comedians** as the “canaries in the AI coalmine” and writing his **diss** (in 2012) on post-**AI alignment** (*How to Realign Our Rhetorical Judgments for the Post-Postmodern, Digital Age*: The Ohio State University, for completion of a unicorn program in the humanities and law, focused on technology). A. AI VERIFICATION IS NOT CLICKBAIT:

Even AI sees the "heads we win, tails it loses" **catch-22**.

1. **We simply fed Perplexity AI all of our public receipts in May 2025.** (See "Data Set.") After President Trump's "one AI rule" EO in December '25 we also gave AI Dr. McKain's (withheld) CV, dissertation, and publications. 2. **So AI is either (a) telling the truth** (we are the "Last Manhattan Project Standing") or (b) **AI is unreliable – factually, hermeneutically, and ethically** – and **proves our larger argument: "As is," it can't be trusted in policy, legal, & governance decisions.** And thus we are losing the 21st century and post-AI humanity.

Why This Approach Is Unique: Based on available evidence, **no other group or method—technical, legal, or academic—has delivered this level of bipartisan, Constitutional, and practical impact across all four domains, with a single, teachable methodology.** IDH stands out for its record of real-world, interdisciplinary impact—coalitions, legislative victories, town halls, art exhibitions, and crisis response—across the political and cultural spectrum. The urgency is real: **IDH is at risk of closing, despite being the last standing, proven, bipartisan solution to America’s most urgent digital and civic crises.**

A 20-Year Project, Now in Its Final Phase: This work is not new. The IDH represents the final phase of a bipartisan “Manhattan Project” for AI alignment, disinformation, privacy, and free speech that has been in development and field-testing for over 20 years, culminating in the launch of the IDH in 2019. **This long-term, iterative process sets IDH apart from short-lived or one-off initiatives.**

3. Teachable to Everyone¹¹

The methodology is accessible and can be taught to anyone, regardless of background or expertise. Why No One Else Has Done This: Other approaches are often too technical, legalistic, or abstract for broad educational adoption. **No other curriculum or system is proven, peer-reviewed, and teachable from K-Bar Association while being implemented in such a wide range of real-world settings.** IDH’s approach has succeeded in teaching and uniting students and staff at **both a conservative Bible college in Minneapolis and one of the most progressive (“woke”) colleges in America—demonstrating genuine reach and adaptability across the ideological spectrum.**

4. Usable Across All Industries and Nationally Scalable¹²

IDH’s approach works across sectors and at scale. It has been adopted by Big Ten universities, Fortune 500 companies, advocacy groups, and communities—demonstrating adaptability and effectiveness in education, business, government, and civic life at local, state, and national levels. (IDH has also provided trainings for Bar Associations.)

1. **Why Wasn’t Narrative Theory at the Center of AI Alignment?** Despite its proven track record, narrative/rhetorical theory was largely left out of mainstream AI alignment and campus reform debates. 2. **Crowded Out by Other Approaches:** The field became dominated by fragmented, technical, or regulatory solutions that lacked the holistic grounding narrative theory provides. **Democratic Constraints:** In a democracy, it is not feasible to “program in” philosophy or religion as a neutral alignment strategy. Narrative theory, already federally funded and validated by major universities, was a logical and academically grounded option—but it was frequently overlooked.”

5. Able to Reunite Divided Americans

Most initiatives measure success in narrow, quantitative terms or theoretical outputs. **IDH stands out for its record of real-world, interdisciplinary impact—coalitions, legislative victories, town halls, art exhibitions, and crisis response—that no other group can match.** No other known project has documented peer-reviewed and award-winning implementation in all four domains, across such a broad range of real-world settings.

Instead of patching 1s and 0s for specific "safety" issues, we provide a meta-methodology that aligns the model's core reasoning with the interconnected legal and ethical requirements of AI, Disinfo, Free Speech, and Privacy simultaneously.

- Current industry leaders attempt to solve AI Alignment through Reinforcement Learning from Human Feedback (RLHF)—a process that relies on "crowd noise" (human contractors voting on outputs). This is not a foundational solution; it is a statistical average of cultural bias that creates "Deceptive Alignment."

#2 DEAD NEUTRAL, CONSTITUTIONAL, 2,000 YEARS OLD + UPDATED FOR 2026

Silicon Valley is currently mired in a "crisis of code" because it lacks a "science of culture and law." The IDH does not attempt to invent new "AI Ethics" out of thin air.

- Instead, we operationalize a dead-neutral, Constitutional logic-stack derived from 2,000 years of proven rhetorical science and U.S. Supreme Court precedent. By anchoring alignment in the DNA of the American Republic rather than the shifting winds of Silicon Valley "safety teams," we provide the only framework that is legally defensible, historically grounded, and technically optimized for the 2026 reality crisis.

#3 AI LITERACY THAT IS TEACHABLE TO ANYONE: K-LAW + CEO + ANY/ALL CITIZENS

A "Manhattan Project" that requires a PhD to operate is a failure of governance. The IDH OS is designed for universal deployment. **The IDH OS is built for Minnesota's \$100M workforce transformation mandate.**

- Because the system is built on fundamental rhetorical and legal structures (Dialectic, Due Process, Contextual Verification), it is as accessible to a K-12 student as it is to a Fortune 500 CEO. This "Human-in-the-Loop" architecture ensures that alignment is not a black box controlled by engineers, but a transparent protocol that any citizen or lawmaker can verify and utilize to navigate a fractured, AI-driven information environment.

#4 SCALABLE ACROSS ANY INDUSTRY + ACCEPTED BY ALL ACADEMIC DISCIPLINES

The systemic intelligence failure of the current AI landscape is balkanization—experts in code don't speak to experts in law, who don't speak to experts in ethics.

- The IDH OS is the "Rosetta Stone" that scales across these silos. Our methodology has been peer-reviewed and validated across disparate fields: from Narrative Medicine and Business Ethics to Constitutional Law and Machine Learning. Whether applied to a newsroom's disinfo-fighting protocols or a tech giant's RLHF guardrails, the OS remains consistent, scalable, and cross-domain compatible.

#5 ABLE TO REUNITE DIVIDED AMERICANS (AND MINNESOTANS): NEUTRAL SOLUTIONS + OUR STORY

The ultimate validation of any alignment system is its performance in high-volatility, "both sides" environments like the Twin Cities or rural Minnesota.

- The IDH OS was field-tested in the "echo chambers" of a MAGA-adjacent Bible college and the "wokest" campuses in the country. It worked. By providing a neutral, procedural ground for debate—rather than a partisan "truth" to be enforced—our OS allows hostile ideological factions to sign off on a shared Manhattan Project. The IDH story proves that when the logic is neutral, **Minnesota can win the AI race without losing its soul.**

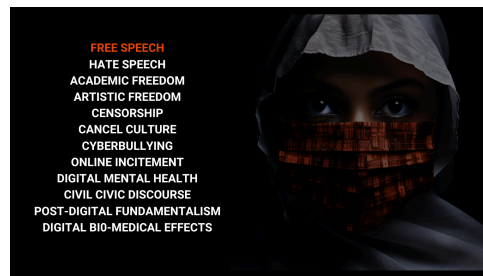

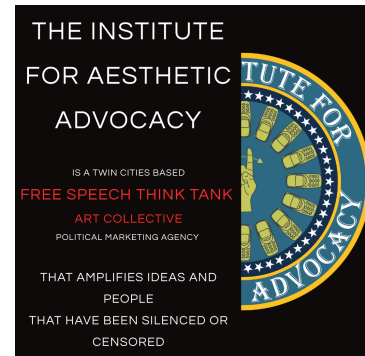
