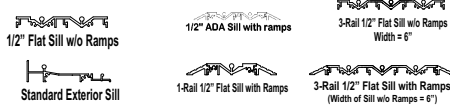


# Required Information to Order a Metal-Craft Slider

**Ship Via:** Anything over 108" must ship common carrier. OXXO, OXXOO and OXXXXO can be spliced in middle to avoid common carrier freight. Freight cost is not included in pricing. These are the shipping options:

**Customer pickup**  
**UPS**  
**Common Carrier**

**Sill:** Flat sills are primarily used for interior transaction windows and doors. The flat sill does not have a screen rail. If the flat sill is to be used for an exterior application, it is recommended that the customer use a sill pan. Metal-Craft can cut drain channel and drill weep holes in sill.



**FINISH:** Metal-Craft has four finishes available. We can special powder-coat paint to "best-match" the customer's paint sample. The finishes are:

**Mill**  
**Clear Anodized**  
**Bronze Anodized**  
**White Paint**

**Glazing:** Metal-Craft has a rail system for monolithic 3/16" or 1/4" thick glass and a rail system for 5/8" or 3/4" IG. Check with glass supplier for recommendation for IG thickness. 3/8" polygal or Lexan can be used in monolithic rails without glazing vinyl. If special glass is required, Metal-Craft can glaze and assemble with customer's glass. Some of the glazing options are:

**KD Open for 3/16" or 1/4" (No Glass)**  
**KD Open for 5/8" or 3/4" (No Glass)**  
**Glazed with Tempered 3/16" or 1/4" Glass**  
**Glazed with 5/8" or 3/4" Tempered Clr over Clr**  
**Glazed 3/4" Tempered LowE over Clr (Cardinal 366)**  
**Metal-Craft will Glaze Customer's Glass**

**Handle:** Options include:

**Grey/Black/White Standard 9300 Handle**  
**Adams-Rite Flush-mount handle**  
**9700 Brushed-chrome or Black-nickel Handle**  
**Thumbturn Assembly with Separate Mortise Lock**

**Keylock:** Keylocks can be keyed-alike or keyed-differently. Keylocks are 7 pin Schlage locks and cannot be keyed to a master key.

**Screen:** Screens can be assembled for local pickup or sent as a kd-kit. For most of the screens assembled at Metal-Craft, aluminum wiring is installed. However, Metal-Craft can install clear or charcoal fiberglass, pet-proof or super-screen. The kd-kit includes everything except the screen material.

**Misc:** Any special instructions or options should be listed here. Special options include autocloser, j-bar security bar, and extra thumbturn assembly.

**Frame Size:** The customer must determine the deduct from the rough opening to make the frame dimensions. Typically, for a replacement door with square framing, the deduct is 1/2" from the width and 3/8" from the height. Typically for a service window, the deduct would be 1/4" from the width and 1/4" from the height.

**Glass Size:** All panels to have the same-sized glass, except for select configs such as XOX with wide middle panel and service windows with autoclosers. For IG glass, we restrict the size of the glass to 30 square feet. Please contact your glass manufacturer for their recommendation for the glass makeup. For 3/4" IG, the glass should 3/16" with a 3/8" spacer. If windows are to be installed above our doors it is critical that the verticals of the Metal-Craft door align with the verticals of the window.

**Configuration:** Looking from outside, X is vent panel; O is fixed panel. The following details represent most but not all configurations:
