



Mary's Story

In January Of 2024, I read an article in the Jamul Shopper about Tina's personal training. I had recently retired and really wanted to add strength training to my hiking/walking regime. I was very hesitant in calling at first as I had been injured, with weight training, in the past and had avoided weights for 15 years. I made that call to Tina in January 2024 and so glad I did! I started work out sessions with Tina and knew right away she was the trainer I needed. Tina listened to all my concerns and was so knowledgeable about muscle group and correct form in use of weights. I looked forward to my weekly sessions and her excellent guidance with all types of weights and challenges as I got stronger and more confident. In the past, I thought you had to feel pain to gain strength; but learned through Tina that is not how she trains. I worked up to heavier weights and lost 10 lbs and was starting the next level when I experienced a major setback in May of 2024.



I had a terrible fall backwards at home and broke my wrist requiring surgery. The ER doctor and surgeon told me I was extremely lucky and felt my training helped tremendously from not experiencing any back injury. What a setback of 7 months! I was determined, in my OT therapy, to get the strength back in my wrist/hand prior to my injury and was released to start training again. in January 2025, I started back with Tina and she was very instrumental in guiding me through my strength recovery journey and I'm stronger than I was in May 2024! This has been the best year and I'm so blessed to have Tina in my life as a trainer and friend in our Jamul community!

I met Tina several years ago when she worked at my dentist's office as a dental technician. Her beautiful smile and joyful spirit made a lasting impression on me. After that first visit, I had not seen Tina in several years. I had a regular workout consisting of 3 miles, 5-6 days a week, with light weights, and routine stretching, at Cuyamaca College. All that changed at a Women's retreat through Shadow Mountain Community Church in 2018. Tina was attending the same retreat and sitting at the same lunch table with me. She had that same smile and joyful spirit! As we began to catch up, she started to share her passion for Training women. She offered to train my friend, Victoria, and me two days a week. She said, "If you train the right way, you will not need to work out 5-6 days a week. Give me two days a week in the gym, and you will see a transformation in how you look and feel." She was right! Tina's training consists of weight training with no jumping or running. The goal was to build muscle without impacting the joints. I definitely noticed a significant change in how my body looked and felt. My joints and muscles felt stronger. Through Tina's specialized training, I've condensed my workouts to 2-3 days a week. Her personalized approach and positive reinforcement are a gift from God. Through her own personal journey, she continues to impact lives for God's glory. Thank you, Tina, for making a difference in my life and so many others'. You are a blessing!



Historical Happenings along the Campo Highway (Hwy 94)

Again I want to remind you that when I write about occurrences before I was old enough to remember, I am writing from my memory of stories told to me by my family, the Ferguson's.

The 1916 Flood was talked about a lot. The Otay and Sweetwater dams both broke and many houses washed into San Diego Bay. My father, Louis Merz was working for the Ferguson Bros. at the time. He was plowing with six horses on hay land they owned where Lemon Grove is now located. The ground was so wet they knew they could not work again for days, so they told my dad to take his team to Jamul. At that time, there wasn't a bridge across the Sweetwater River. When my dad arrived at the river in the afternoon, he misjudged the depth of the water in the crossing. He was riding one horse and leading five. When the horses entered the water, they immediately began swimming due to the depth. Dad released the five horses he was leading and they swam across the river. He could not make the horse he was riding cross, it swam back to the side of the river that it had entered.

The only house in the area was on the North of the current intersection of Jamacha Road and Hwy 94. Dad went there, cold and wet, they told him he could come in and sit by the wood cook stove to dry off. They proceeded to eat their supper but didn't offer him

any food. After supper the family went to bed, leaving him sitting by the cook stove, talk about pioneer hospitality.

The next morning, Dad went back to the river. The five horses he was leading had gone on to Jamul. When he arrived at the river he saw people from Jamul on the other side of the river looking for his body, thinking he had drowned.

After the 1916 Flood, San Diego County built a timber bridge at the river crossing. The next flood was in 1927 and washed out the timber bridge. A cable was then installed across the river with a car. The locals called it a bucket, that hung on rollers and could be pulled across the river by the occupants. The steel bridge was then built. The bucket was used for transporting mail and supplies until the river receded and could be crossed prior to the completion of the steel bridge.

My grandmother was scheduled for surgery in San Francisco. She wanted my mother, a registered nurse, to be with her. When I was just a year old, my mother and I crossed the river in the "bucket" and were met by relatives from San Diego that took us to the coastal ferry. At that time, there wasn't any direct rail passenger service from San Diego to San Francisco. The coastal ferries, as they were called, traveled from San Diego to San Francisco. They were the most comfortable method of travel with meals and sleeping facilities on board.






