JAMUL DULZURA COMMUITY PLANNING **GROUP -**

On September 6th, **JDCPG** (Jamul Dulzura Community Planning Group) voted unanimously to support the County's Fire Safe and VMT Efficient Alternative. On September 13, the County Board of **Supervisors (BOS)** approved the strong Climate Action Plan and a related smart growth plan that will reduce greenhouse gas and fires. The BOS adopted the Fire Safe Low VMT (Vehicle Miles Traveled) Efficient Alternative smart growth plan described in the Environmental Impact Report that provides incentives to shift housing out of severe high fire areas and closer to services and transportation opportunities to reduce traffic, preserve wildlife habitat and decrease air pollution. Our East County supervisors voted against it because they said it would limit development and effectively mean No Growth, which it won't.

SENATE INDIAN AFFAIRS COMMITTEE -

On Wednesday, September 18th, the Senate Indian Affairs Committee voted on the Jamul Indian Village Land Transfer Act, S 3857. Of Course, JDCPG

A cartoon in our Sunday paper reminds me of a story about 30 years ago when I was a member of the Jamul Ca Volunteer Fire dept....

Seems we all used to hear the calls that came in from Sheriff's Dispatch and whoever was closest to the call would either respond in

their personal car or go to our local fire station and jump on the truck to respond to the call...

Up at Indian Hills Bible Camp we had a barn with an old 1975 fire engine in it and most importantly Indian Hills had a couple of "First Class" Medics:... Dan Bell and Bob Lindsey, counselors at Indian Hills, ready to respond any time of day or night...

One fine Sunday afternoon a call came in for all to hear on our pagers: "Cat in a Tree"...at the Trading post on Lyon's Valley Road near Skyline Truck Trail.....



About five minutes or so no one had answered the call when our Vol Fire Chief John Baker, came on the radio.... "We do not respond to cats in trees"... Soon the dispatcher acknowledged our Chief and I thought that was it. By and by another voice came on the pager... "This is Dan Bell responding to the Trading Post." I guess he went and used the radio in the Firetruck but responded in his own vehicle as I do not believe he was an authorized Fire Truck driver at that time.

I don't even know if he had a ladder but the next time we heard from Dan on the radio he had gotten up the tree and retrieved the Cat for a very happy lady. Kudos for Dan... I think she rewarded him with a plate of cookies because I did see some cookie crumbs on the front seat the next time I drove 7213...:

That's my Story and I'm stick'n to it.... Dave Beekman

DEERHORN VALLEY ANTLER

ELENA LANE FIRE: The PulsePoint dispatch posted about 1:15 pm on Thursday, Sept. 19th for a vegetation fire on Elena Lane. CALFIRE initiated a full response air and ground attack.

The fire had started on an array of backyard solar panels. Fortunately the homeowner had just arrived home, smelled smoke, then saw the flames moving up the slope toward their home. They immediately called 911.

Firefighters shut the solar panels down and extinguished a 10'x10' fire. They suggested the owner schedule an inspection— a good reminder to all of us to get our systems checked on a regular basis. It could have been so much worse. PII YOU DO

BEE VALLEY FIRE: Around 4 PM, CALFIRE called another full response for a vegetation fire on Bee

Valley Rd in Upper Deerhorn. SDG&E had just finished installing new equipment, and when full power was restored, fire broke out. Even though old wooden poles are being replaced with new (still wooden) poles, equipment can still arc. and sparks easily ignite the tinder-dry grass that



surrounds us. (NOTE: A similar fire broke out on Elena Lane in 2022 when just-inspected equipment sparked a fire that quickly moved toward homes. It was only the quick thinking and actions by neighbors driving by that kept the fire small until fire units could arrive.)

IGNOSCI POSSE— 18 Years at the 9/11 Memorial Stair Climb

The Ignosci Posse has made an appearance at every San Diego 9-11 Memorial Stair Climb event since it began18 years ago. Each year local DV folks have climbed up to 110 stories in memory of the 403 emergency responders who died at the

World Trade Center on Sept 11, 2001.

The San Diego even is held at the Bayside Hilton Hotel, so most climbers repeat 30-story climb multiple times to reach 110. Other climbers do as many steps as possible. Volunteers at every landing provide meals and support. Sandra, Sharon Gladding and Susie Norton, all cheered on the climbers arriving at the 30th floor.

The Ignosci Posse Team is spearheaded by DV'er Sandra Ignosci, whose firefighter brother, Randy, was a first responder on 9/11— part of the San Diego team sent to assist in the aftermath of the attack and collapse of both towers.

SPECIAL NOTE: This year Sandra was awarded a very special plague by the firefighters for being the Top 9/11 Memorial Stair Climb Fund Raiser over these last 18 years. Kudos and a big salute to you all. You make us all Deerhorn Proud.

DVCA COMMUNITY POTLUCK: Patti Hazard opened the meeting at 6:00 welcomed everyone to her barnand what a beautiful barn it is!
