W Tuition Payments:

Each Monday is considered a new session week. All payments for your camper should be made prior to the start of the new session week on Fridays. Payments can be made on our website at www.maketheplay.net, through PayPal, or on our campsite with our Camp Administrator. Payments are accepted in cash, credit card, or check form. All checks must be made payable to Jaguar Booster Club.



Jaguar Snack Shack:

The Jaguar Snack Shack offers our campers a variety of snack options. Campers can bring a daily allowance to purchase items from our concession stand or allocate a weekly allowance into their accounts for their use. All snacks sold at our concession stand are peanut-free. Prices will vary. If your camper prefers to bring money daily for snacks, please secure any cash in an envelope with your child's name.



Camp Coaches/Supervisors:

All our camp coaches/supervisors have been with us since the start of our camp. Some of our coaches are Pines Charter High School Alumni. All our campers will be grouped and instructed based on specific age groups. Weekly evaluations will be provided to each student to track and celebrate their progress.



Daily Lunch:

Lunch is included in the MVP camp package. Pizza will be ordered on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, and Subway on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Subway order options include the following: Ham, Turkey, Tuna, or Veggie and include a chocolate chip cookie. All subway orders are taken upon sign-in on those specific days.
