Cole's Campground Park Rules

General Rules

- Quiet Hours—Strictly enforced at 10:30 pm weekdays (Sunday to Thursday) and 11:30pm weekends (Friday and Saturday). Excessive loud noises and profanity will not be tolerated. During quiet time music must be turned off and no playing of instruments.
- Speed limit in the park is 9.5km/h. Stay Slow, stay aware!
- No ATVs, dirt bikes, or any other off-road vehicles are permitted to be driven in the park, inside the gate.
- <u>Bicycles</u> Helmets must be worn at all times. No biking after dark.
- Office- Shirts and shoes required. No Scents. No pets in office.
- <u>In case of emergency</u> first call 911. Then call the office at 902-757-2401 to inform management of the situation.
- <u>Unsupervised pool</u> to be used at your own risk. Follow all rules of the pool as posted in the office and poolside. Swimming in pond is at your own risk.
- <u>Please respect</u> all fellow campers. No abusive language, violence, or harassment will be tolerated. Do not cut through lots, use the roads.
- <u>Smoking</u> No smoking in Rec hall, any building, or outside public washrooms, only in designated areas or on your deck. Dispose of your butts in the receptacles. Cannabis is not permitted in general public areas, only in designated spots or inside your camper. No illegal substances permitted.
- <u>Alcohol</u> No alcohol permitted past the Gate. Drinking and driving inside the park or leaving the park will NOT be tolerated. No alcohol at kids events, and no one under 19 is permitted to have alcohol in their possession.
- Water Taps Make sure they are turned off. Not for kids to play with.
- <u>Outhouse Doors</u> Please keep doors closed, and toilet seat lids down.
- <u>Management</u> is not responsible for any occurrences that take place away from the campground.

Events

 <u>Dances</u> –Shirts required at all events. Swimwear not permitted. Do not loiter outside the hall after dances; sound carries to neighbours. Must be 19+ to attend adult events ie dances, washers, etc. Organizers are responsible for cleanup after any events.

Children

• You are responsible for your children at all times. Do not leave children unattended. Children must be back to their lot by 11pm. Toys and bikes must be picked up and out of the way.

Pets

 <u>Dogs</u>–You are responsible for your pets' actions. Must be on a leash around the park. Do not leave them alone in your trailer when leaving the park. You must clean up after your pets. Dogs must not be a disturbance ie excessive barking. Dogs that bite anyone will be asked to leave the park.

Fire

- <u>Fires in Pits</u> Keep them low burning in appropriate fire pits, especially in wooded areas, and do not leave them unattended. Do not move fire pits. Must follow all fire bans and restrictions (check daily at 2pm). Outside firewood is not permitted; it can carry outside bugs and diseases. Order your firewood at the Office by 6pm.
- <u>Fireworks</u>: Campers are not permitted to set off fireworks within the campground.

Garbage

<u>Dumpsters</u>

Regular camping garbage only, in black bags. Must sort recycling into clear or blue bags- plastic and cardboard to be placed in Recycle Shed. Bottles to be placed in Bottle Recycling Shed. Please put compost in compost bin. Please do not put furniture or renovation debris in dumpsters. Take anything else home with you to dispose of. Dog poop goes in the garbage, not recyclable.

We are a privately owned campground. We reserve the right to refuse admission or ask anyone to leave based on our judgment. We ask your courtesy and cooperation in obeying the rules and our staff. Disrespect will not be tolerated.

These rules are for your own benefit and protection and are intended to make this campground a safe place for relaxation and enjoyment.
