

Franchise Tax Ended	The entity's franchise tax responsibilities ended because the entity has ceased to exist in its state or country of formation or has ceased doing business in Texas.
Franchise Tax Involuntarily Ended	The entity's registration or certificate was ended as a result of a tax forfeiture or an administrative forfeiture by Texas Secretary of State.

State of Formation

The state in which the entity is organized.

Effective SOS Registration Date

The effective date of a Texas entity's formation document or an out-of-state entity's registration document filed with the Secretary of State. Generally, a document takes effect when filed by the Secretary of State. However, a formation or registration document may have an effective date that occurs after the date the document is filed by the Secretary of State.

Texas SOS File Number

The Texas SOS File number is the number assigned to an entity registered with the Texas Secretary of State.

Registered Agent Name

An individual resident of Texas or an organization that is authorized to transact business in Texas who consents to act as an agent for the entity for
