

Adira - Adopted in WA
Spayed, Female
American Pit Bull Terrier Mix
1 year old, 45lbs
Heartworm Negative

Adira is a beautiful dog that is friendly, but unsocialized. She was found abandoned in the streets of Houston with severe mange. Adira was broken down in fear and warehouse by the rescue, isolated from other dogs and human contact for over 6 months as they collected donations on her behalf.

Adira was thankfully spayed and her tail was amputated by the previous rescue. Adira is amazing with people, and requires slow introduction to new dogs, as she is shy, but non-aggressive. This dog needs a foster home and a little bit of patience to come out of her shell. This is a very loving, beautiful dog with a lot of potential.



Balboa - Adopted in WA Neutered, Male English Mastiff 1.5 years old, 85lbs Heartworm Negative

Balboa is a young English mastiff mix. Don't let his extra-large frame fool you. This guy is an affectionate, goofy puppy with loads of personality. In true mastiff form, he can be a bit shy when meeting new people, but bonds quickly.

Balboa is house broken, and crate trained. He is good on leash but is very strong so we recommend a martingale type lead that can easily control if he gets too excited. Balboa is medium to high activity and loves to run and play. He will need regular exercise and mental enrichment to be the best boy possible. A savvy adopter with breed experience is highly recommended. Balboa is good with kids and other dogs but has not been cat tested.



Bejeau - Rescue transferred Spayed, Female Plott Hound Mix Adult, 50lbs Heartworm Negative

Sweet Bejeau was abandoned in boarding for over 1 year by her original owner. She is a very well behaved and well-adjusted dog. Bejeau was owned and surrendered with Malachi, and both dogs are very fond of one another. The pair does wonderful together but can be separated. Both dogs are good with kids and a little shy meeting new dogs but do fine with slow introduction. They have not been cat tested.



Branch - Still in boarding Neutered, Male American Pit Bull Terrier Adult, 50lbs Heartworm Negative

Branch is a high energy, playful dog that loves toys and is extremely food motivated. He has proven to be good with kids and is friendly with dogs that have a matching energy when properly introduced. Branch has not been tested with cats. He has exhibited some barrier frustration in a kennel environment and is very vocal but is an otherwise sweet and well-mannered dog in a home. He is easily stressed in a shelter environment and would be best suited in a foster home. Branch is housebroken, crate trained and does well on a leash.



Butter - Adopted in WA Spayed, Female American Pit Bull Terrier Adult, 45lbs Heartworm Positive

Butter is a girl who loves to go! She is a very happy girl who is full of life and energy. Butter interacts well with children and loves to play fetch. She's also a huge fan of water and the water hose. She is a more dominate girl and does well with slow introductions to new dogs. She does best with submissive, lower energy dogs.

Butter came to her previous rescue with her puppy and father of her puppy, a chihuahua. They were all kept together in a small wooden room until the male and puppy were transported. Butter then spent her time in a wire kennel on a rotation schedule with limited interaction with other dogs. She was finally partnered with another male dog who would go outside to the cement outside area with her. There were never any issues between either dog during their time together.




Captain - Adopted in WA Neutered, Male Hound/Shepherd? mix Adult, 60lbs Heartworm Negative

Captain is a super friendly, big boy. He would do best in an active household who enjoys training as he could use a brush up on basic manners and obedience. He is much like a giant puppy and does well in group dog play situations with some direction from handlers. He was attacked by another dog as a puppy and suffered damage to the bone plate beneath the eye. Required surgery to place a metal plate for the injury. One side of his face is slightly malformed due to condition; otherwise healthy. Good with kids. Not cat tested.



Cherry - Still in boarding

Cherry was abandoned on the streets of Houston with severe mange and no hair. She was pulled by a fraud rescue who received donations for her care, which she never received. Despite all that Cherry is a wonderful, extremely happy, high energy girl. She does well with other large dogs and children. Lived in a household with small children and multiple dogs for several months. She will be spayed prior to transport. Not cat tested.



Clarke - Still in boarding Neutered, Male American Pit Bull Terrier Senior, 50lbs Heartworm Positive

Clarke was rescued in the 5th Ward after Hurricane Harvey. He was pulled by a fraudulent rescue and sat in their facility for several months, then abandoned in boarding for over 2 years. He is dog friendly, and lived with other dogs, including a pack of small dogs in the streets. Since his abandonment, he has lost a great deal of his social skills and will need time and effort to readjust. He is currently in a foster home and doing wonderful. Will likely need a foster and time to decompress prior to adoption.



Cora - Adopted in WA

Cora is a beautiful, happy and an all-around well-behaved dog. Cora is a high energy dog who loves to play. She enjoys children and other dogs. Cora is crate trained, walks well on leash and knows some basic commands.

Cora has spent the past year living in boarding. While in boarding she attended play group with dogs her size and larger. Cora would do best with someone who is active as she has lot of energy and is eager to learn and please. Unfortunately, Cora was not treated for heartworms with her last rescue and still needs treatment.



Elvis - Listed for Adoption, still in boarding or Barb's house after being taken from WA

Heartworm Negative



Emma is a beautiful girl who loves other dogs. Emma started her life on a chain in a backyard with very limited interaction with humans. She is a medium level dog who can be shy and can be slow to warm up to new people. Emma prefers woman but with time will warm up to males as well.



She lived in boarding for over 2 years where she was not exposed to many new people or things, however she is coming out of her shell and learning to trust more and more every day.



Four - Adopted in WA
Neutered, Male
American Pit Bull Terrier
Adult, 60lbs
Heartworm Positive

Four is a beautiful dog with an amazing disposition. He is a medium level energy dog who does great with children. Four is good with other dogs but prefers to interact with dogs in small groups verses a setting with a larger group of dogs such as a dog park. Four is a very quiet dog who is well mannered, good with commands, crate trained and does well on leash.

Four has been living in boarding for over a year and had very limited interaction with other dogs. While in boarding he was very quiet, clean and well-mannered in his crate. When he was introduced to group play, he was overwhelmed with the number of dogs and shut down. He has never shown signs of aggression. Four does have a tumor on flank that will need to be removed.



Frankie - Still in boarding (note from early 202 the rescue acknowledged she does not do well in a shelter/kennel environment but still has her in one)



Sweet Frankie is a plain black dog with cherry eye who really needs a chance. She is dog selective but has done okay with some dogs with proper intros. She does not do well in a shelter/kennel environment and will need an experienced foster home prior to adoption. She is amazing with people. Not cat tested.



Gwen - Still in boarding Spayed, Female American Pit Bull Terrier Senior, 45lbs Heartworm Negative

Gwen is a low energy female who is looking for a quiet family to relax with. She currently has a palpable lump in her throat which we are still trying to diagnose. Gwen is dog selective with females but is good after proper introduction. Good with kids. Not cat tested.




Kiya - Adopted in Canada Spayed, Female American Pit Bull Terrier mix Adult, 50lbs Heartworm Negative

Kiya is an awesome girl. She is so excited to be alive. Extremely happy, high energy dog. Does well with other dogs and children. Has some anxiety issues in crate, busted kennels in boarding; now with foster, doing much better. Bony bump on left wrist; to be examined by surgeon. Possible tumor.



Malachi - Rescue Transferred Neutered, Male Hound/Shepherd? mix Adult, 50lbs Heartworm Negative

Malachi was abandoned in boarding for over 1 year by his owner. Despite it all he is very well behaved and a well-adjusted dog. Malachi was owned and surrendered with Bejeau. The pair does wonderful together but can be separated. He is a little shy when meeting new dogs. Good with children. Not cat tested.



Mona - Still in boarding (note from early 202 the rescue acknowledged she does not do well in a shelter/kennel environment but still has her in one)


Spayed, Female American Pit Bull Terrier mix Adult, 60lbs Heartworm Negative

Mona is a great girl. She is good with children and good with most dogs after a proper introduction. She is medium energy and doesn't thrive in a kennel environment, currently she is exhibiting some barrier frustration behaviors. Would do best in a foster home.



Porkchop - Died in boarding, RIP Neutered, Male American Pit Bull Terrier Senior, 50lbs Heartworm Positive

Porkchop is an amazing senior Pit Bull. Don't let his age fool you -- he thinks that's just a number! This high energy boy is friendly with other dogs, especially females. Good with children. He tends to obsess over tennis balls and his metal bowl if left alone and bored in crate or room. Very playful dog. He is high heartworm positive. Unfortunately, he suffered extreme trauma to his skull prior to rescue; fixation may be neuro related. Wonderful dog deserves a chance despite his looks & age.



Rhino - Adopted in WA Neutered, Male American Bully Adult, 50lbs Heartworm Positive

Rhino is a great dog. Good with other dogs and kids; some issues with over arousal, if gets too excited. Professionally trained/rehabbed. Did amazing in his foster home with kids and other dogs. Needs a cardiac work up.



Skye - Still in boarding, medically fragile senior dog who is friendly with other dogs and children... never networked.

Spayed, Female American Pit Bull Terrier Senior, 50lbs Heartworm Positive


High energy, very sweet senior.
Heartworms are very advanced. Abandoned in boarding for 2 years, hair loss due to trauma. Skin is permanently scarred; hair will likely not grow back. Friendly with other dogs. Good with children. Wonderful dog deserves a chance despite her looks & age.



Sybil - Still in boarding (note from early 202 the rescue acknowledged she does not do well in a shelter/kennel environment but still has her in one)

Spayed, Female American Bulldog Adult, 70lbs Heartworm Positive

This big girl needs a bull breed experienced home. She is dog selective but okay with proper introduction. She is not thriving in a kennel environment and needs a foster home. She is amazing with people, easy to handle/touch. Needs a very strong handler, as she pulls on leash. No cats. Has been good with children.



Jett - Finally listed for adoption after over a year with severe medical issues, still in boarding

Neutered, Male American Pit Bull Terrier mix Adult, 50lbs

Heartworm Negative

This loving boy is Jett. He came to us with severe skin issues and hair loss related to allergies and poor nutrition/care. He is an extremely dog friendly, happy go lucky guy. Great with children. Not cat tested.



Jewels - Adopted in WA Spayed, Female Shepherd Mix Senior, 60lbs Heartworm Negative

This beautiful blind girl is Jewels. She is a special needs dog. Due to her prior time in boarding she developed confinement anxiety and cannot be enclosed in wire kennel. She also displays signs of severe separation anxiety will harm herself if left alone. This dog needs another dog to keep her company. She is amazing with other dogs. Not cat tested but likely due to being blind would be okay with proper introduction and management.



Keke - Adopted in WA Spayed, Female American Pit Bull Terrier Senior, 50lbs Heartworm Negative

Another one of our wonderful special needs dogs is Keke. This girl has an endearing partial facial paralysis as you can see in the photo. She is very calm with Jewels, but playful and appropriate with young puppies. Wonderfully behaved, amazing senior dog.



Leo - Adopted in WA, passed away within a few months of adoption

Neutered, Male American Pit Bull Terrier Adult, 65lbs Heartworm Positive

Leo is an amazingly cool, calm & collected dog. He gets along well with others, loves food and is a sweet, gentle boy. He's amazing with kids. We have not cat tested him, but he is likely friendly. This dog has a very low drive, is respectful of your personal space and is very well mannered. Light positive for heartworms, on pretreatment. Previously had entropion, surgically corrected and no vision issues.



Saylor - Adopted in WA Spayed, Female American Pit Bull Terrier Senior, 50lbs Heartworm Negative

This pretty girl is Saylor! She is low energy, but excited for food and walks. Very sweet dog, good with other dogs. Excellent with people and kids, needs a lot of attention. Can be mouthy at times but has no teeth. Very gentle. Watches cats but has lived with them without issue. Small, benign tumors. Previously had large mammary tumor and septic uterus (removed).

Sylvan is an extremely happy, high energy dog. She does well with other dogs and children. Our volunteers love her and describe her as a very well-behaved beautiful dog. She is good with commands, and easy on leash. She has not been cat tested.
