In Barbara Zuluaga's own words, from her own messages ---

May 2017 - B told someone who was watching 2 dogs for her (Luna and Chewy) that she had 22 dogs in her home. At this time she was still referring to Natalie as her rescue partner, so I don't believe she had started working with A Chance to Bloom yet. This was my first time ever dealing with Barbara, my personal friend and foster in Houston volunteered to watch her dogs for her while she was out of town. I believe Amanda Lynn was still house sitting for her at that time too.

It was early/mid 2018 that I offered to do home checks and be a back up foster for her and Jessica if they wanted to facilitate adoptions in the PNW. They were using 3LP for those transports.

11/25/18 - 39 dogs in her 1,488 sqft house and half acre lot

December 2018 - 41 dogs in her house

1/4/19 - 23 dogs in her house

October 2019 she started using KDS

11/5 & 11/24 2019 - HSPCA visited her home

ACTB Eviction 12/11/2019

ACTB dogs pulled 12/11 & 12/12 2019

1/22/20 - ~25 dogs in her home

6/19/20 - 35-40 dogs at KDS paying \$5,700 a month in boarding fees

March 2021 - at least 28 dogs (including several litters of puppies) in her home see screen shot in comments

Barb claims she took in "over 100" dogs from A Chance to Bloom but when we counted it was actually only 48 dogs...

So where did those other ~52+ dogs come from?

Is it feasible they were already with her based on these numbers?

I'll let you be the judge of that.

And if that's accurate how is she trying to pin this all on Jessica Russell?
