
The **Study** was designed with a mid century mood of a den in combination of strong blue and teakwood.

It can also be converted to a guest bedroom by opening the sofa cum bed.











The **Kitchen** was retained but given a new look by repolishing the veneer and changing the knobs to brass,


PLAYROOM IMITATING PAST








All wooden furniture in the office is designed with minimal yet functional approach.

2nd floor-Employers floor including workstations, private cabins and breakout area












Water, rocks and plants create a context for meditating on eternal truths; bridges carry us from one station to another; the greenery provides an occasion to connect with our various selves.







The project brief was to design a tiny house in **London.**Since london is facing a huge **housing crisis** and looking forward for new solutions, We proposed these **modular hexagonal units** which can create **co-living** spaces inside existing vacant commercial buildings.









MOOD THROUGH SECTIONS

Since we decided to use **abandoned old buildings** in Clerkenwell , we created an **industrial moodboard** using concrete, corten steel and huge translucent glass windows allowing maximum natural light.






Aster Cucine is build on a strong background of fabulous quality products with various moods, thus for their showroom design, we developed the concept of **Aster between the lines:**

The 5 kitchen moods are **divided** into their own independent zones by using **light partitions** with motion censors in the lower ground floor.










ASTER LOUNGE between the showroom & the city
