

ADMISSION PROCESS

Calvary West Christian School does not have an open admission policy. CWCS is a discipleship school accepting Christian youth from Christian families. In order for a student to be accepted he must meet certain criteria spiritually and CWCS must be able to meet his needs in all areas.

Round One: This first phase of the admission process consists of the following steps:

- 1. Submit the application for admission and testing
- 2. Submit copy of last report card or official transcript
- 3. Submit copy of most recent standardized test scores
- 4. Submit references from most recent Math teacher, English/literature teacher, and Pastor or Youth Pastor
- 5. Take placement exam

Round Two: This phase will consist of a personal interview with both student and parents.

Round Three : After a student is officially accepted into CWCS, the following paperwork must be submitted **<u>before</u>** student is able to attend classes:

- birth certificate
- copy of social security card
- immunization records
- official transcript and cumulative record from previous school
- school physical
- completed enrollment pack
