April is looking BUSY! Here is what the students are doing this month:

<u>Blue room</u>

This month we will be focusing on:

- Counting and writing numbers up to 100
- Introducing money
- Practicing more music and refining the sense of hearing by matching the bells

<u>Red room</u>

This month we will be focusing on:

- Finishing up farm animals in Spanish
- Introducing food related vocabulary
- In practical life, the students will be practicing shoe tying and polishing
- For a lesson in grace and courtesy, we will practice setting the table & inviting a friend
- Introducing food related Practical Life works such as carrot peeling and lemon juicing

Green room

This month we will be focusing on:

- Revisiting basic skills
- Representational drawing skills
- Learning how to break down drawings and paintings through object - shape correspondence (e.g., an orange is a sphere)
- Creating programs, props and the backdrop for our Spring Sing performance

Rainbow room

This month we will be focusing on:

- The United States in Geography and learning about Native Americans
- Continuing to study lifecycles including amphibians, butterflies and mealworms
- Welcoming spring with units on seeds, plants, the birds and the bees
- Practicing lowercase letter writing, sight words, sentence building, poems, reading, and grammar
