Here is what the students are doing this month:

Math

- Reviewing and continuing to explore abstract addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.
- Strengthening addition and subtraction, especially within 1-20.
- Continuing to explore money by gathering different amounts, paying for items at a store, and learning to add and subtract with money.
- Introducing how to read time analog and digital.

Sensorial Skills

 Continuing to decipher differences in music notes, geometric shapes, color hues, and textures.

Art

- Continuing to revisit and hone basic skills
- Continuing to explore painting on the easel and crayon melting
- Creating programs, props, and the backdrop for our Spring Sing Performance

<u>Spanish</u>

 Continuing to practice basic vocabulary such as animals, colors, greetings, parts of the body

Language

 Practicing lowercase letter writing/ handwriting, sight words, sentence building, poems, reading, and grammar.

Science and Geography

- United States Geography
- Continuing to study lifecycles including amphibians, butterflies, and mealworms.
- Welcoming Spring with units on seeds, plants, the birds and the bees.

Music

 Continuing to learn about music through the Montessori Bells, Melody Harp, Carnival of the Animals, and Notation on the Musical Staff.

- Cleaning vegetables
