Beth's mom and dad have a big ranch. Beth has a pet calf.

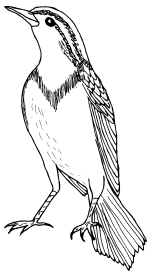
Buck is Beth's chum. Buck's mom and dad have a big ranch too. Buck has a pet lamb.

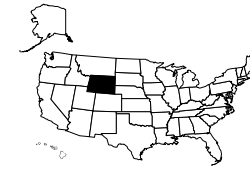

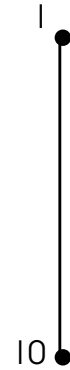

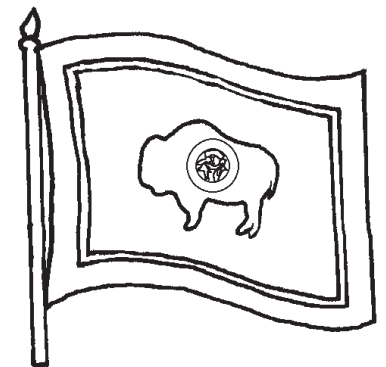
