



English Results

2022-2023

Phonics

- 11 Year 1 children took part in the phonics screening test. 8 of the 11 children met the standard. 72% of Year 1 children met the standard. (2 special education needs children and 1 other did not pass the test)
- 1 Year 2 child had to re-sit the test. They did not meet the standard (1 special education needs child was 1 mark off)

Key stage 1

17 children in the cohort.

- 70% of children achieved expected in reading. 24% of children were working towards. 6% of children achieved greater depth.
- 76% of children achieved expected in writing. 24% of children were working towards. 0% greater depth.

Key Stage 2

17 children in the cohort.

- 82% achieved the expected standard or better in reading. 29% of children achieved greater depth. 18% of children did not reach the expected standard. (1 SEN child, 1 English as an additional language, 1 low ability at KS1)
- 94% of children achieved expected or better. 24% of children achieved greater depth. 1 child did not reach the expected standard (1 special education need child did not reach the expected standard))
- 94% of children achieved expected or better in writing. (1 special education need child did not reach the expected standard))
- 24% achieved greater depth.

Reading progress=0, writing progress=2.1 GAPs=-1.0
