How to stop it?

If you feel like you are being bullied then the first thing to do is tell a teacher or a trusted adult who will work with you to solve your problems.

Stay positive and stay safe.

These actions might help you: Tell them you don't want them to carry on. Walk away/ignore them. Use the worry box if you are scared to speak to someone.
