A Snowmans Journey

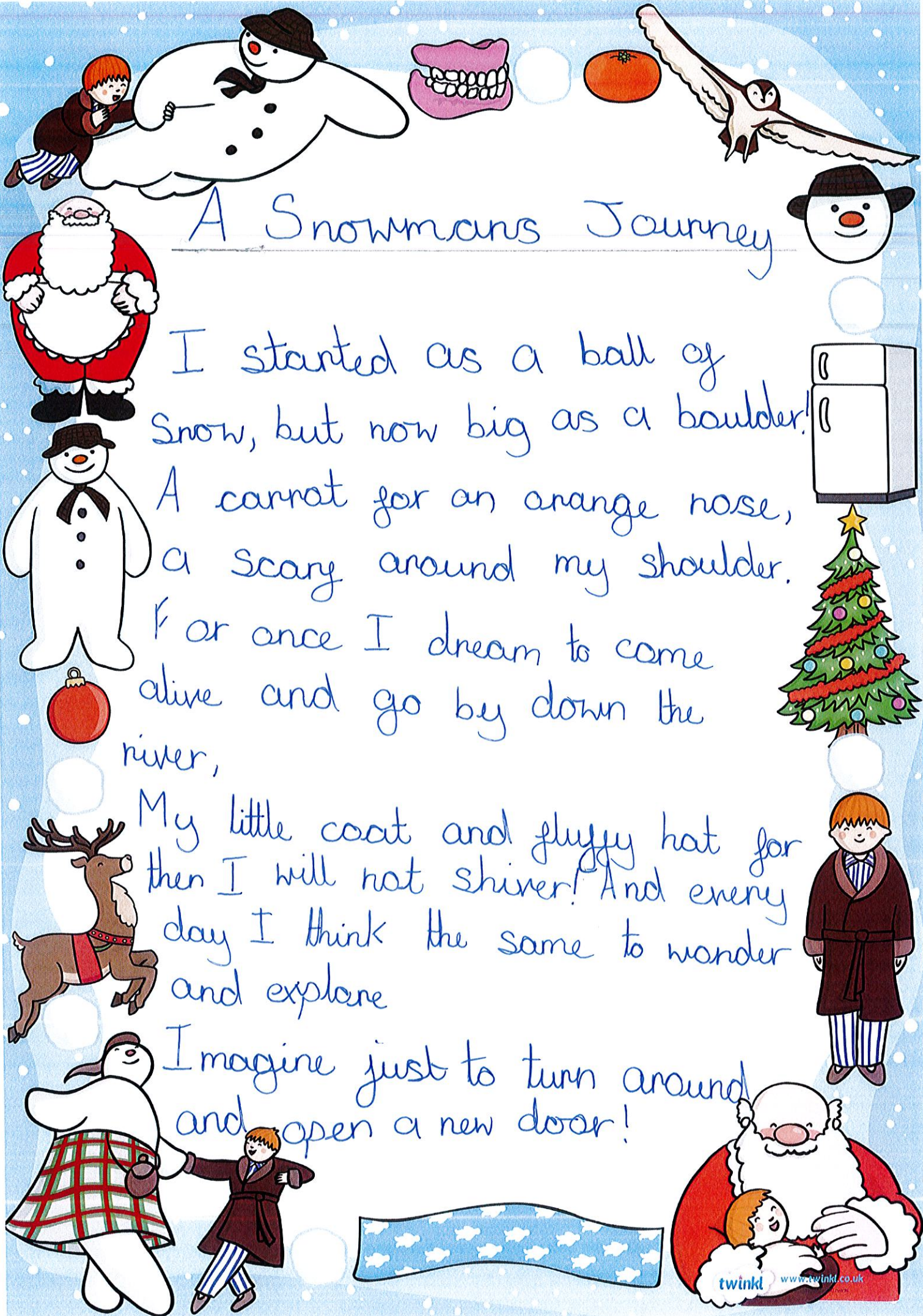
I started as a ball of
snow, but now big as a boulder!


A carrot for an orange nose,
