

What to do if you or someone you know are being bullied

- Tell an adult straight away. Don't be afraid and stay silent
- All types of bullying are to be reported. If it is online, in text messages, face to face and outside of school
- If you see someone being bullied, don't try and sort out the problem yourself. Report it.
- Keep evidence of the bullying especially if it is cyberbullying
- Ignore the bully and walk away. You are more strong minded to do this
