Dear Parents,

I would like to remind everyone about the importance of road safety around the school at drop-off and collection times.

Despite recent reminders in our newsletter, we continue to see vehicles parking on the zig-zag lines outside the school. These markings are there to keep the area directly outside the school entrance clear so that pupils can cross the road safely and so that drivers have a clear view of children entering and leaving the site. Unfortunately, we have recently had several near-miss incidents reported, which is extremely concerning.

We must therefore ask all parents and carers not to stop or park on the zig-zag lines at any time. Doing so places pupils and families at unnecessary risk and breaches the purpose of these safety markings.

In addition, we have noticed a number of vehicles left idling with engines running while waiting outside the school. Idling engines contribute to air pollution around the school gates, which affects the health and wellbeing of our pupils and the wider community. We ask that you switch off your engine if you are waiting.

The safety of our pupils is our highest priority and we ask for your cooperation in helping to keep the area around the school safe for everyone.
