Dear Parents/Carers,

Trips

Forest School

If your child brings a packed lunch to school, please ensure it is healthy and balanced. We ask that you do not include sweets or chocolate. Instead, try to pack a portion of fruit to help keep your child energised and focused throughout the day.

Every Friday this half term the School Council will be running a pop-up stall selling the ice lollies at break time. Wraparound Care

From September 2025 we are looking to provide wraparound care from 3.30pm-5.30pm with an option to have one hour or the full two hours of childcare. Our external sports coaches will be delivering these sessions at a competitive price. We hope to finalise these arrangements after half term and we will keep you updated.

Safeguarding

For safeguarding purposes please could you only enter the school building if you have a prior appointment. If you do need to come into the building before or after school, please report to the school office and sign in. It is essential that we know who is on the premises at all times to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all our pupils, staff and visitors.

Coats

Please ensure that your child comes to school each day with an appropriate lightweight, waterproof coat.

Breakfast Club

Everybody is welcome to attend Breakfast Club Children need to arrive before 8.20am. After 8.20am children will need to come in through the playground gate at 8.40.

Gates

We aim to open the school gates at 8.40 every day to help parents with drop off, however the school day does not officially start until 8.50. I would like to politely ask parents to be patient on the very few occasions when the gate can't be opened at 8.40. It is so important that we have the correct staff in place before we open the school. If you feel that you are rushing in the morning please use the free breakfast club.
