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Dear Parent,

During the first and second week in June the statutory Times Table Check for Year 4 pupils will take place. The electronic test consists of 25 questions that have to be answered individually in 6 seconds or less. To pass the test the children need to get all 25 questions correct.

All the children have made amazing progress and they are now all scoring in the 20s or achieving full marks! Thank you so much for supporting your child at home with this! As a challenge over half term we are asking pupils to complete a daily times table check on purple mash and to only submit their score when they achieve 25/25. (Children can repeat the check as many times as they like until they get full marks) All children that achieve a daily score of 25 will receive a prize when they return to school. We will also award prizes to those children that have made the most progress.

This is meant to be a fun challenge and not a laborious task. Children should only be spending between 5-20 minutes each day on this site. Pupils can access Purple Mash and complete the challenge independently, however they may need reminding each day. I do appreciate that some children may be going away and I do not want this to spoil family time. Please just treat this challenge as 'a bit of educational fun'
