

Impact of Sports Premium 2017-2018

Swimming

- Swimming tracking 2017-2018 shows that 97% of children could swim 25m by the end of the year.
- 100% of pupil premium children could swim 25m by the end of the year.
- 100% of all junior children participated in the annual swimming gala which took place in July 2018

Soccerstars

Soccerstars have provided a lunchtime club for Key Stage 2 children throughout the year.

Impact

• 94% of junior children have participated in one or more sessions.

Dance Club

A dance student provided afterschool dance with a specific aim of engaging girls in physical activity. This club was also open to boys.

Impact

- 63% of Key Stage 2 girls attended this club on a regular basis.
- 75% of pupil premium girls attended this club on a regular basis.
- 100% of children performed at the Festive Afternoon and the Summer Fair where parents were invited to attend and they have also performed routines to the whole school.
- Dance club has become increasingly popular. For 2018/2019 a year 5/6 programme of dance will take place for 14 weeks and then a year 3/4 programme of dance will take place for the next 14 weeks

Netball Club

A teaching assistant who is a current netball player provided afterschool netball sessions with the aim of engaging children in competitive sports.

Impact

- 60% (18 out of 30) of junior girls participated regularly in the netball club.
- 75% (3 out of 4) pupil premium girls took part in the netball club.
- 13% of boys (4 out of 30) participated regularly in the netball club
- Netball club has become increasingly popular. For 2018/2019 two netball clubs will take place; one for upper juniors and one for lower juniors.



Sports Premium has been used to set up a small school multi-sport programme of competitive fixtures for children in Key Stage 2.

The indoor programme has included:

- Dodgeball
- Benchball
- Hockey

The outdoor programme has included:

- Football
- Tag rugby
- Rounders

Impact

- 43% of Trent children have participated in at least one competitive event.
- 70% of Griffon children have participated in at least one competitive event.
- 83% of pupil premium children participated in at least one competitive event.

Forest School

Justin Comasky successfully completed the Forest School Level 3 Leadership programme.

Impact

- A 6 week programme of activities is in place for year 1 to year 6 children.
- 100% of children from year 1 through to year 6 took part in these activities.
- A range of outdoor equipment has been purchased to support Forest School activities.

Cycling

Cycle Derby provided time trial cycling sessions for year 5 and year 6 children.

Impact:

- 100% of year 5 and 6 children took part in these sessions
- 100% of children took part in the time trial competition at Weston School

Inter-School Sports

In addition to the Tri-School Sports competition we have competed in a variety of interschool events, including:

- Triathalon for year 5 and year 6 children at Woodlands School
- Year 5 and Year 6 football fixtures
- Year 5 Soccerstars tournament at Derby County



Sports Week

A full programme of sports was provided throughout the week which included:

- Teambuilding activities
- Trip to Markeaton challenge Academy for Key Stage 2 children and Clip 'n' Climb for Key stage 1 children.
- Football tournaments
- Circuit training
- TAG rugby sessions
- The Barrow Mile
- Forest School sessions
- Swimming Gala practice
- Archery sessions

Impact

- 100% of children participated in these events
- Pupil questionnaires show that children enjoyed activities and many commented on the new skills they had learnt.

Lunchtime

In April 2018 Play workers replaced lunchtime supervisors in order to provide more physical and stimulating activities for all children.

Impact:

- New equipment has now been purchased for both playgrounds
- A programme of activities is in place for both playgrounds which is changed fortnightly.
- The new trim trail is built into the programme of activities enabling all children to access this.
- Lunchtime play worker training has taken place
