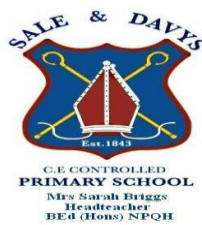

Year 6 Trip- 4th July & Year 5 Trip – 6th July

Transition Days
