

## **National test results 2018-2019**

### **Key Stage 2 SATS Results 2019**

#### **Reading** (16 children in total)

- 93% of children achieved the national standard compared to 75% nationally.
- 63% of children achieved greater depth compared to 28% nationally.

#### **Maths** (16 children in total)

- 100% of children achieved the national standard compared to 76% nationally.
- 50% of children achieved greater depth compared to 24% nationally

#### **Writing** (16 children in total)

- 93% of children achieved the national standard compared to 78% nationally.
- 19% of children achieved greater depth compared to 20% nationally.

#### **Grammar punctuation and spelling** (16 children in total)

- 93% of children achieved the national standard compared to 75% nationally.
- 75% of children achieved greater depth compared to 34% nationally.

### **Key Stage 1 results (19 children in total)**

#### **Reading**

- 94% of children achieved the expected standard compared to 76% nationally.
- 26% achieved greater depth compared to 25% nationally.

#### **Maths**

- 94% of children achieved the expected standard compared to 75% nationally
- 32% achieved greater depth compared to 21% nationally.

#### **Writing**

- 78% achieved the expected standard compared to 75% nationally
- 26% of children achieved greater depth compared to 16% nationally.

#### **Grammar punctuation and spelling**

- 94% of children achieved the expected standard compared to 78% nationally
- 42% of children achieved greater depth. ( no greater depth NA)

**Phonics Screening (16 children in total)**

- 88% of children passed the phonics screening test compared to 83% nationally.
- 100% of year 2 children who previously failed the phonics screening test passed it in the re-take.

**Early Years Foundation Stage**

72% of children reached a 'Good Level of Development' compared to 71% nationally.
