Tuesday evenings

Junior Voices - This group of singers is for children in Y3-Y6. They are taught

a range of music and are introduced to part-singing. The children are encouraged to use good diction and tone, and

to develop their vocal range and musicianship.

Club Band - For those who are in the very early stages of learning the

flute, clarinet or brass instruments. Players need to be able

to play three or four notes before joining.

Junior Wind Band - For players who perhaps have been playing flute, clarinet or

brass instruments for about a year. The standard of playing is

usually Grade 1-3.

Family Brass Band - For brass players of approximately Grade 4+. A number of

the players are members of the same family – hence the name! However, brass players of all ages are welcome.

Youth choir (Year 6+) - A four-part choir (sopranos, altos, tenors & basses) so boys

whose voices are breaking are particularly encouraged to

join this thriving ensemble.

Friday evenings

Intermediate and Senior Bands - This group caters for players approximately at Grade 4+ level. . There are opportunities for sectional rehearsals. From time-to-time guest conductors are invited to work with the band.
