**Re: weekly update**

**Warm clothes**

Please ensure that your child has a thick, warm, winter coat, hat and gloves for school. Children will be going outside every day even in the rain! It is also important to remember that government guidelines state that rooms need to be well ventilated so cardigans, jumpers, and tights for girls will be most suitable until the weather improves. Thank you

**Water bottles**

Children will need to bring a named water bottle to school every day.

**Pencil cases**

Junior children may bring a pencil case to school, however, it must remain in school until the Easter holidays.

**Lateral flow tests**

Lateral flow Covid tests are now available to families. Please see our recent letter on the website for more details on how these can be obtained.

**Drop off and pick up from 8<sup>th</sup> March**

Just a reminder about picking up and dropping off. Children with a last name that starts between A-N should arrive before 8.50am and should be collected at 3.20pm. Children with a last name that starts between O-Z should also arrive before 8.50am and should be collected at 3.30pm. Please ensure that you arrive at the right time slot to avoid waiting around. Thank you.

Have a great weekend and we look forward to seeing you all on Monday.


