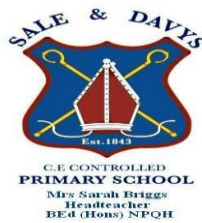

Ofsted Update

No One Word Overall Judgement Grade to be given to Sale and Davys

There have been several different Ofsted inspection frameworks and handbooks since our school was last inspected. In line with recent national changes Ofsted will no longer give a single word overall judgement grade to any school in their reports following school visits. This is a positive development - reading the fuller report will provide deeper and broader information about schools. The government has issued new statutory regulations on holidays in term time. You will still be fined if you take your child on holiday in term time. The amount of the fine has increase to £180 per parent per child. Parents who take children on holiday for a third time during term time will automatically be referred to the Magistrates court.
