Topics: Our main topic for this half-term is "France". This is predominantly a Geography topic, focusing on particular aspects of French life, culture and demographics. We will also weave elements of sport into the topic as we will be engaged in Sports Week and Sports Day as well as examining a number of sports and sporting events.

In **PSHE** we are exploring relationships, including aspects of growing up and SRE (Sex and Relationships Education). Please see our website for further details.

Computing will focus on web searching and browsing along with the ongoing theme of online safety. **RE** will be thinking about the importance of The Bible in Christianity and comparing with Jewish holy texts. **Geography** will extend map and compass skills, with a human geography focus on France. **PE** has a focus on Teambuilding and Athletics.

In **Music** we will be revisiting and consolidating the songs and skills learnt this year.

PE: Every Thursday afternoon. Please send your children to school wearing their PE kit and trainers on these days.

Swimming lessons are on Tuesdays. This half term they began on 3rd June and will run until 1st July. Your child will need an appropriate swimming costume and towel, contained in a draw string bag. Please see the school website for appropriate swimming kit.

Homework: The children have their homework grid in their green homework books. Please encourage your child to complete one piece of homework per week. Wherever possible these will be marked and returned on the same day. We will be using some of the homework to populate our Topic Display.

Class Book: We are continuing to read "Secrets of a Sun King" by Emma Carrol.

Spellings and Tables: Spellings and tables tests are on Thursdays. Please spend time with your child learning these in preparation. They will also bring home new work to learn on Fridays.

Handwriting Pens: Erasable "Frixion" pens and refills are available to buy from school. Please use Parent Hub for payment. The children will then collect them from the school office.
