Dear Parents,

Firstly, a big thank you for your support during the last few weeks with SAT practice papers being completed at home. The children have worked hard to develop their skills and extend their knowledge in all areas covered. They have shown incredible focus and resilience and we are very proud of them.

With SATS now completed, we turn our attention to the next phase of learning – transitioning to KS3. There will be tasks to focus on and projects provided by secondary school to complete but there will also be time for the children to spend time on their own topics and enjoy some extra forest school sessions. Added to this, we will be arranging an opportunity for the children to have a forest school session hosted by the YMCA in collaboration with our 'Justice and Responsibility' area of the curriculum.
