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




Welcome to Divine Buzz. We hope this welcome pack will answer any questions that you may have regarding the Youth club and activities that we offer.

Our Code of Conduct

Behaviour rules and expectations of club members

Respect: All members are expected to show respect to their peers, club staff/volunteers, and property. Disrespectful language or behaviour will not be tolerated.

Participation: All Members should do their best to engage and contribute positively to the club's activities.

Safeguarding: Safeguarding is our primary focus. Members must adhere to all safety requirements/instructions provided by club staff and volunteers. If you refuses to follow staff instructions, you will be given a verbal warning on the first incident, a written warning on the second occurrence, and if the behaviour continues, you will be permanently excluded from the club.

Bullying: Bullying, in any form, is completely prohibited. We are dedicated to providing a friendly environment in which all members feel welcome and safe.

Punctuality: Timeliness is important for the smooth operation of club activities. Please ensure your child arrives and is picked up on time. Parents arriving late to pick up their children means staff have to stay extra time to look after them which results in extra cost to the club. Persistent latecomers will be penalised to compensate staff expenses.

Equipment: Participants must handle all pieces of equipment with care. It is important not to damage or abuse the resources and equipment. if you purposely damage club equipment or property, you will be asked to pay for the replacement cost.

Abuse: No form of abuse will be tolerated from either a young person or a parent. Anyone who abuses a member of staff/volunteer or other members

DBS DISCLOSURE

At Divine Buzz, the safety and wellbeing of your child are our top priorities. Consequently, it is our policy that every adult who works directly with your child undergoes a 'DBS check.'

This ensures that all adults holding roles within our organization have been thoroughly DBS checked.

GENERAL DATA PROTECTION ACT (GDPR)

Divine Buzz complies with current data protection laws and principles, including the EU GDPR effective from 25th May 2018. These principles ensure that information is:

Fairly and lawfully processed

Any person may request that their details be removed from our records at any time, or request a copy of their information at any time.

Health & Safety
