- To prepare and develop teaching materials, teaching programmes, methods of teaching and assessment using clear differentiation as well as the necessary pastoral arrangements.

- To design assessments in line with the pupil's learning abilities and needs, assess, record and report on the development, progress and attainment of pupils; academically, socially and personally; and use the assessment data to guide future session plans
- Ensure effective teaching of the whole class whilst establishing high expectations of behaviour and attainment so that learning outcomes are met.
- Engage with the pupils to ensure sound learning and discipline and maintain a safe, pleasant, stimulating and positive learning environment in which pupils feel confident.
- Use a variety of teaching and learning styles to keep all pupils engaged. Be familiar with the Code of Practice and identification, assessment and support of pupils with SEN.
- To deliver sessions in line with the standards of the national curriculum
- Evaluate your own teaching critically to improve effectiveness.
- Be punctual and set a good example to the children.
- Take pupil attendance in assigned sessions
- To communicate and consult effectively with the parents of children and the Manager
- Supervise the work of any support staff, including teaching assistants, who are assigned to work within the sessions.
- To carry out administrative duties as necessary e.g. maintain accurate attendance registers, and carry out risk assessments, etc.
- Have knowledge of and keep up to date with the Curriculum guidance for Key Stage 2 , especially in the area of KS2 SATs

## **Other professional requirements:**

- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with the Divine Buzz staff, contractors, volunteers, and parents.
- Participate as required in meetings with Divine Buzz staff, contractors, volunteers and parents in respect of the duties and responsibilities as detailed above.
- Be aware of the need to take responsibility for your own professional development outside of the regular training provided by Divine Buzz.
