
#### **About Us**

#### **At Woburn Safari**


An exciting place to see the wildlife face to face in their enclosures


For most of the parents and children, it was their first time experience, it was exciting and enjoyable for them seeing the wildlife.

and laughter






### All on aboard the Woburn train


#### **New Discoveries**

#### What have we learned

The exposure to the Safari has helped the children to contextualise what they learn in class and seen on TV

The exposure has shaped the children's understanding in a way that is much more informative than if they only relied on classroom and TV knowledge

The children discover a much wider world out there compared to what they are accustomed to in their immediate environment

We discovered that many more families than we anticipated were looking for the opportunity to visit such places, however, unable to visit due to cost

Trips like this are more effective way of bring communities together.

- Have time to see more of the Safari park, as our time was quite limited


#### What would you do differently next time

- Planning smaller but multiple trips to the same places
















## The difference the project made to the community
