

# 11th Annual Concerto Scholarship Competition (2018-2019)

This competition is open to flutists ages 14-18 as of January 15, 2019.

**Required repertoire:** one movement of a flute concerto arranged for flute solo or piccolo solo and flute choir. The piece must be selected from the repertoire list that appears on the next page unless the flute choir arrangement has been approved in writing by Debbie Gilbert, artistic director, before the entry deadline (**January 4, 2019**). Please contact Debbie Gilbert at <a href="jdgilbert99@gmail.com">jdgilbert99@gmail.com</a> for prior approval of a piece not on the suggested repertoire list.

Entries must be postmarked no later than: January 4, 2019

To enter, send a high quality CD in mp3 format consisting of the required repertoire played by the flutist with piano accompaniment, plus the audition form, photo/video release form and a \$30.00 non-refundable audition fee to:

Make checks payable to "Woodbridge Flute Choir." Label the CD with name of flutist, school and title of piece. DO NOT send video recordings.

#### Audition process:

- 1. The recorded CDs will be evaluated and the Finalists will be chosen and notified by **January 14**, **2019**.
- 2. Finalists will perform the required repertoire, with accompanist, before a panel of judges **January 26**, **2019** at 10:00AM at Abiding Presence Lutheran Church. Each semi-finalist must provide his/her own accompanist plus 3 copies of the piece they are performing. One winner will be chosen.
- 3. The winner will rehearse his/her repertoire with the Woodbridge Flute Choir and will perform as a featured performer in Woodbridge Flute Choir's **Sunday, March 17, 2019 3:00 PM** concert at Greenwich Presbyterian Church, 15305 Vint Hill Rd, Nokesville, VA 20181.
- 4. All finalists are invited to be a part of the Woodbridge Flute Choir during the Sunday, **March 17**, **2019** concert and perform with the choir on one or two pieces. However, those finalists must be able to attend two of our Thursday evening rehearsals before the concert.

The Grand Prize Winner will receive a \$500 scholarship prize.
