

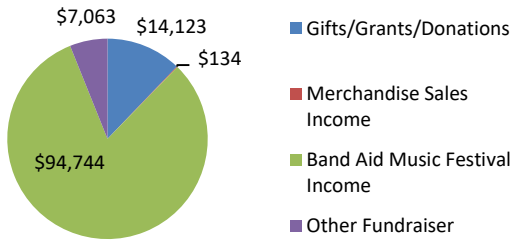
# COASTAL AUTHORITY CARE FOUNDATION 2022 ANNUAL REPORT



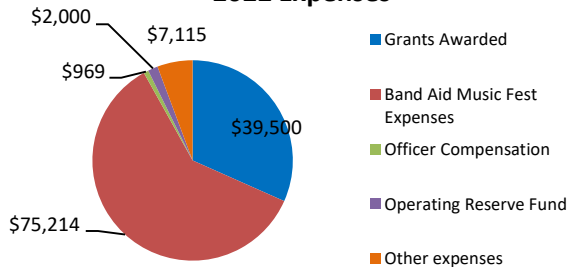
## OUR MISSION

Coastal Authority Care Foundation, Inc. is a nonprofit corporation that provides grants to veterans with service-connected injuries, especially traumatic brain injury, post-traumatic stress and chronic pain. Our Emerging Therapies Grant program helps pay for cutting-edge therapies, such as hyperbaric oxygen therapy and neurofeedback, that is not covered by insurance, which provides healing of the wound in the brain, symptom relief, helps restore quality of life and ultimately, helps prevent suicide. Additionally, we may also provide grants to veterans, their spouse or other accompanying family member to help pay for travel and lodging expenses associated with therapy.

## TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY: #1 INJURY OF U.S. ARMED FORCES

Over 470,000 diagnosed TBI cases have been reported worldwide since 2000 but there are many more that go undiagnosed and untreated. Persistent symptoms can lead to numerous health issues, mental health issues, breakdown in relationships, cognitive issues and suicide. Studies show nontraditional therapies such as hyperbaric oxygen therapy and neurofeedback help heal the wound in the brain and provide symptom relief; however, insurance does not cover it. With Hampton Roads being home of the largest Navy base in the world and so many military retirees, it is critical that we have these therapies available here.

## GRANTS AWARDED and NUMBER TREATED

CACF gave nearly \$40,000 (up from \$11,000 in 2021) in hyperbaric oxygen therapy or neurofeedback grants to help a total of 11 veterans. Grants typically range \$2500 to \$5000.

**FUNDRAISING: Veterans Band Aid Music Festival** is our biggest fundraising event of the year the weekend following Memorial Day at The Holiday Trav-L Park in Virginia Beach, Virginia. Headliners included Orianthi (Rock) and The Ultimate Hank Williams Jr. Tribute Band “All My Rowdy Friends” (Country) with other performances by popular local bands. Proceeds of approximately \$20,000 went to our grant program. Attendees doubled from 800 in 2021 to 1500 in 2022.

**Brews and BBQ for Heroes** silent auction at Froggie’s in Virginia Beach in October helped us raise an additional \$7,000 for our grant program.
