### CANONISATIONS AND DECLARATIONS

Blessed Carlos Acutis and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati will be canonized as Saints in St Peter's Square in the Vatican by Pope Leo XIV on the 7th of September, 2025. Both died very young. Carlos, known for his deep devotion to the Eucharist, his care for the less privileged and for using his technological skills to evangelise—especially with his creation of a website showcasing Eucharistic Miracles around the world was 15 when he died of Leukemia in 2006 while Pier known for his deep spirituality, his charitable works especially through his involvement with SVP, contracted polio while caring for the sick in his community and died at the age of 24 in 1925.

**Also St John Henry Newman, canonized in 2019 by Pope Francis, will soon be declared the 38th Doctor of the Universal Church.**
