

***CROYDON DEANERY NOTICE**— Kindly note that at the last Croydon Deanery meeting, Parishes were asked to have a reduced summer mass schedule for the weekend masses, which will **‘take effect each year on the third weekend in July, and continue to include the first weekend in September.** It is an Archdiocesan-wide initiative and is meant to give some respite to the priests as well as based on the number of people attending each particular mass – (In the majority of parishes across the Archdiocese, parishioners are away for some time in summer, and Mass attendance falls). Discernment and discussions are still ongoing but it looks quite likely that the 6:00pm Sunday Mass— only during the period mentioned above—may be affected. This will mean if that is the discerned way forward in Summer 2026, there will be no Sunday 6:00pm Mass during that period. We shall keep everyone informed — and please do read the bulletin always — but in the meantime please note this year’s dates, if that is the way forward: On Sunday, 19th July 2026 there will no 6:00pm Mass until Sunday, 13th September 2026 when the 6:00pm Mass resumes.
