**Terminally Ill Adults (End of Life) Bill** - On Friday 20 June, Archbishop John Sherrington (led bishop for Life Issues) and Cardinal Vincent Nichols each issued statements following the Third Reading of the Terminally Ill Adults (End of Life) Bill. Both statements can be found on the [Bishops' Conference website](#) and are also attached for your convenience. The Bill now proceeds to the House of Lords for further scrutiny and debate. As you know, Archbishop John has consistently raised his voice in defence of the most vulnerable. In response to Friday's vote in the House of Commons, he stated that the result marked "a terrifyingly dark week in British history, as MPs vote for legislation which endangers the lives of unborn children, and promote legislation which will endanger vulnerable adults and the elderly." Peter's Pence is, in essence, a gesture of communion — an expression of solidarity with the Pope in his work of proclaiming the Gospel, promoting peace, and extending Christian charity to those most in need.


