NOVEMBER: MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS – In November, the Church encourages the faithful to pray for the souls in purgatory and offers indulgences to assist them; pious practises which highlight the Church's teaching on the Communion of Saints. The Church grants a plenary indulgence (the full remission of temporal punishment due to sin) each day from 1st to the 8th November to those who visit a cemetery and pray, even if silently, for the departed. Additionally, a plenary indulgence is available on 2nd November, All Souls' Day, for those who devoutly visit a church or an oratory and recite the Our Father and the Creed.

To gain these indulgences, <u>Catholics must fulfil the usual conditions</u>: be in a state of grace; have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin; receive the Sacrament of Confession (within about 20 days before or after); receive Holy Communion; and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father (usually fulfilled by an Our Father and a Hail Mary). For those unable to meet all conditions, a partial indulgence (the partial remission of temporal punishment) is granted.

Holy Hour for the Dignity of the Human Person

During the November Plenary Assembly of the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales, the Bishops will gather for a Holy Hour to pray for the promotion of the dignity of the human person and the culture of life in England and Wales. This comes in response to the assisted suicide legislation currently before the UK Parliament. The Bishops' Holy Hour will commence at **5.30pm on Wednesday**, **13 November 2024**. Parishes, religious houses, and other institutions within this archdiocese, as well as those in other dioceses across England and Wales, are invited to arrange Holy Hours at the same time, so as to be united with the Bishops in a powerful moment of prayer, that the intrinsic dignity of every person be respected. In St Chad's, we are also having the HOLY HOUR AT 5:30PM <u>ON WEDNESDAY 13TH</u> NOVEMBER. PLEASE LET US, AS A PARISH, COME TOGETHER AND PRAY FOR THIS INTENTION.
