World Youth Day 2027

The Event takes place 2-9 August 2027 in Seoul, South Korea. The cost per person is estimated to be from the region of £2700 to £3000 (if we go with the Spiritans), the cheapest being £2700. About 7 young persons have registered their interest. The budget for now is £18,900. The archdiocese kindly gave us a grant of £3,270—meaning we still need £15,630. Of course the final number of people going depends on the amount we get at the end of the day but we are looking at various possibilities of raising that amount and for that we shall be relying on the usual generosity of parishioners. But for now if anyone feels touched to sponsor a young person, fully or partially, please do not hesitate to contact Fr Ambrose, the Parish secretary, Marnique the co-ordinator (07305948628), Tina (07837797967). You could also use the Dona machines. The break down is as follows:

If 15 people generously give £1000 each we get £15,000.

If 30 people generously give £500 each we get £15,000

If 60 people generously give £250 each we get £15,000

If 120 people generously give £125 each we get £15,000

If 240 people generously give £62.50 each we get £15,000

Please remember we are only appealing to people's generosity because we are making an investment in the young people. Sina and Perpetua went for the World Youth Day in Portugal in 2023 and I am so proud of them because of their involvement in Youth activities in the Archdiocese and in the Parish. It revitalised them and we can enable that to happen to other young people in our parish too.

Spiritans Youth Concert 2026

This event takes place in St Mellitus, Tollington Park, London, N4 3AG. It brings together young people from across the UK, especially London, to worship and praise God together. It is the Spiritan version of Flame. The previous 2 editions have been very successful. So we are encouraging our young people, as many as possible, to join other young people—all coming from Spiritan parishes—for this event. It takes place on the 24th of October, 2026.
