CLASS LEVEL	AGE
Pre-school	3 upwards (Younger students at managements discretion, must be potty trained and confident)
Pre-Primary	4 upwards (Students can take this exam no earlier than 5)
Primary	6 upwards (Students can take this exam no earlier than 6)
Grades 1-5	7 upwards (Students can take these exams no earlier than 7)
Grades 6-8	13 upwards (Students can take these exams no earlier than 11. Adults are welcome to join classes of this level at management's discretion. Email for details.)
Intermediate Foundation	11 upwards (Students are invited to join this class on the strength of their work in other classes. Adults are welcome to join classes of this level at management's discretion. Email for details.)
